What does my child need to bring to school?

- A backpack (big enough to hold a folder and lunch box)
- An extra set of clothes labeled in a plastic bag (will be kept in the classroom in case of accidents/spills)
- A toddler sized sheet and blanket (will be sent home at the end of each week to be washed)
- A morning and afternoon snack (see schedule for approximate snack times)
- Lunch (can bring from home or order from the school)
- Water bottle (labeled)
- Pull-ups and wipes (if needed)

Please label all personal items with your child's name

What should my child wear to school?

- Make sure children are dressed appropriately for playing and learning, inclusive of shoes that are secured on his or her feet for the playground.
- Children will be going outside daily, weather permitting. As the weather is a variable, please be sure to provide a jacket, hat, etc. for your child.
- Our gross motor time involves both indoor and outdoor play.

What does my child need for rest time?

- Children will rest on cots please send in a toddler sized sheet and blanket
- Blankets and sheets will be sent home at the end of each week to be washed.
- Please refrain from sending nap mats as they do not fit in the classroom cubbies.

What does my child need for lunch and snack?

- There is a morning and afternoon snack for preschoolers please send in healthy snacks each day (fruits, vegetables, string cheese, yogurt, apple sauce, goldfish, crackers etc.)
- Students may buy the school lunch or bring lunch from home
- Lunch and snack items are not able to be heated up
- Please try to send in items for lunch and snack that your child can try to open independently
- If utensils are needed for snack and/or lunch please send them in your child's lunchbox

How can I purchase lunch for my child?

- Children at all preschool locations can order/purchase lunch if they choose.
- Please reach out to the location your child will be attending for information regarding lunch procedures.
