- 4. Assist young or disabled students in getting on and off the bus
- 5. If student is medically identified as in need of specific Individual Health Plan:
 - a. Attend IHP meetings as requested by the district
 - b. Complete mandated training assigned by the school nurse
 - c. Protect confidentiality of records and information about students and use discretion when sharing any such information
 - d. Prepare reports as required
- 6. Answer parent questions regarding the student during transporting
- 7. Participates in scheduled emergency bus exit drills.
