Dear Flemington-Raritan Regional School Community,

Early this morning before the start of the school day, I was alerted by the Raritan Township Police Department of a child reported missing in our community. The Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office and the Raritan Township Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in locating the missing child. The Flemington-Raritan Regional School District is actively cooperating with the efforts of the Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office and the Raritan Township Police Department and will continue to provide information and support, as requested, that may be helpful. As this is an ongoing investigation, our District cannot share any details or information other than what has been released by the Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office or the Raritan Township Police Department.

A missing child in our community brings fears of safety for our students, our children, and the children of others. As the community works together to support the family, please take the opportunity to be informed about the facts and ways to help our children and our community. The Flemington-Raritan Regional School District is prepared to offer support through counseling for any child or staff member that may be struggling with concerns about themselves or others. We stand at the ready to provide help in giving all of our children the support they need to deal with this crisis in our community.
