External testing of air quality and surface testing was contracted to a professional outside consultant through R.K. Environmental. As part of the remediation and clean-up plan I am communicating with staff and parents the cleanup process and outcomes of the external testing. I have shared in multiple correspondences that after we had the results of surface and air sample testing I would communicate with all the results of the testing and any further action that was recommended or required. The attachments are quantitative and qualitative reports from the Occupational & Environmental Analysis, Inc. Professional Engineering Service Company; a professional company that specializes in health and safety, environmental affairs, and energy. Mr. Michael McGuinness, a building pathologist has provided reports from the Q Lab of Environmental Microbiology, 254 Bridge Street, Metuchen, NJ 08840. The lab results are posted for your review.

Please know that the health and safety of our students and staff is of the utmost importance to us. We are on target with the professional cleaning to have Copper Hill Elementary completely remediated and the humidity challenges resolved. I will continue to communicate with our community to address concerns.
