Dear Flemington-Raritan Regional School District Parents, Staff and Community Members,

The district received notice of four positive COVID-19 cases. One is a student at Francis A. Desmares School who was last in the building on January 21. Two are students at Robert Hunter School who were last in the building on January 15. One is a student at J.P. Case Middle School who was last in the building on January 12.

## New Recommendations for COVID-19:

The district is now following the most recent recommendations from the New Jersey Department of Health. Updated on January 19, the <u>COVID-19 Public Health Recommendations for K - 12 schools removes the recommendation for schools to exclude close contacts of individuals with COVID-compatible symptoms. While COVID activity in Hunterdon County remains high, schools should continue to exclude staff and students if they have:</u>

- <u>Tested positive</u> (viral test) for COVID-19 Confirmed cases of COVID-19 should stay home until at least 10 days have passed since symptom onset and at least 24 hours have passed after resolution of fever without fever reducing medications and improvement in symptoms.
- <u>COVID-19</u> compatible symptoms All individuals with COVID-19 compatible symptoms who have <u>not</u> been tested should stay home until at least 10 days have passed since symptom onset and at least 24 hours have passed after resolution of fever without fever reducing medications and improvement in symptoms. An alternate diagnosis (including a positive strep test or influenza swab) without a negative COVID-19 test is not acceptable for individuals who meet COVID-19 exclusion criteria to return to school.
- <u>Potential exposure to COVID-19 from</u> Close contact with a person with COVID-19 in the past 14 days (exclude for 14 days); engaged in domestic and/or international travel in the past 10 days (exclude in accordance with NJ Travel Recommendations and essential employees).
- Siblings of a student who has symptoms and meets COVID-19 Exclusion Criteria should be excluded from school until the symptomatic individual receives a negative test result. If the symptomatic individual tests positive, the sibling is required to self-quarantine.
