Dear Flemington-Raritan Regional School District Parents,

Today, June 14th, 2022, all schools in the District completed a monthly school security drill with students and staff. The school completed a drill which simulates the need to use one of the building's automated external defibrillators, otherwise known as an AED. This security drill provides each school's Emergency Response Team an opportunity to train to respond to an event should the staff need to help someone experiencing sudden cardiac arrest.

All students, staff, and faculty were alerted prior to the drill to alleviate any concerns. Students remained sheltered in place in their classroom under the supervision of their classroom teacher. At the conclusion of the drill, it was stated to the students that the drill was completed.

School safety drills are mandated by the NJ Department of Education Office of School Preparedness and Emergency Planning and are conducted in compliance with state and local safety protocols and procedures. Our security drills are performed with prior consultation of local, county, and state emergency personnel. Your child's safety and the safety of our staff and faculty are a top priority at all times.
