#### Language Development & Reading:

~We looked for our <u>Word of the Week</u>: "here" in our books and morning messages.

~In Literacy Centers we:

- read lots of great books in our small groups,

- read and illustrated decodable books,
- identified and generated rhyming words
- identified digraphs in given words,
- clapped out words to determine the number of syllables
- shopped for new books for our book bins.

~In Fundations we are really working on mastering the digraph sounds: sh~ship~/sh/, ch~chin~/ch/, th~thumb~/th/, wh~whistle~/w/ and ck~sock~/k/. We continue to tap out both real and nonsense words, build words using our magnetic tiles, and write words on our dry erase boards.



#### Math:

~We are learning lots about measurement

- We are using our calendar markers to learn about different ways to measure different kinds of things
