Language Arts:

- ~We looked for the Word of the Week: **<u>can</u>** in our books, poems and messages
- ~During literacy centers we:
 - practiced reading and writing our trick words
 - practiced writing our last 4 Fundations letters and sounds
 - identified rhyming pairs
 - identified initial sounds in words
 - read and colored a booklet about things that Rudolph "can" do.
- ~We continued to work on writing opinion stories. This we created books about things that we like to eat. We are really focusing on telling our opinions first, and then recording our ideas using words and pictures with the help of various tools like our word wall, alphabet charts and spacing sticks.
- ~In small group instruction we are using Elkonin boxes to help develop our phonemic awareness skills, playing rhyming games, tapping out words and reading emergent texts.
- ~Fundations We learned our last four letters: u~yellow~/y/, x~fox~/ks/, z~zebra~/z/ and qu~queen~/kw/. We are matching letters with their sounds, writing letters on our dry erase slates and attending to stories. We also played a skywriting game. We have started taking our Unit 1 Assessment.
