SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Paul Freda of Suplee, Clooney & Co. presented the 2008-2009 audit of the Flemington-Raritan Regional School District. Mr. Freda noted one audit finding. It was noted that two signatures were needed on activity/athletic accounts. Mr. Freda noted that the surplus account has decreased from the 2007/2008 but is still at the allowable 2%. The loss of state aid and withholding of the second state aid payment has affected the district. Ms. Hope explained the details of the corrective action plan. She noted all documents will be sent to the county office tomorrow. Ms. Hope commended the Business Office and the Administrators and all staff that are responsible for financial aspects.

Ms. Bell and Dr. Bonieski noted that this is the first recommendation in several years. Ms. Hope owned the recommendation and will ensure that the recommendation is implemented.

In addition to the Standard Operating Procedures being created, Ms. Hope noted the parties responsible, the Treasurer of Monies and the bank involved, will be notified. Internal controls were in place but failed.

The Board discussed the absentee rate of 3.4% which was a decrease from previous periods. H1N1 clinics are becoming available throughout the county.

The Strategic Planning process is moving forward.

Parent teacher conferences are ongoing.
