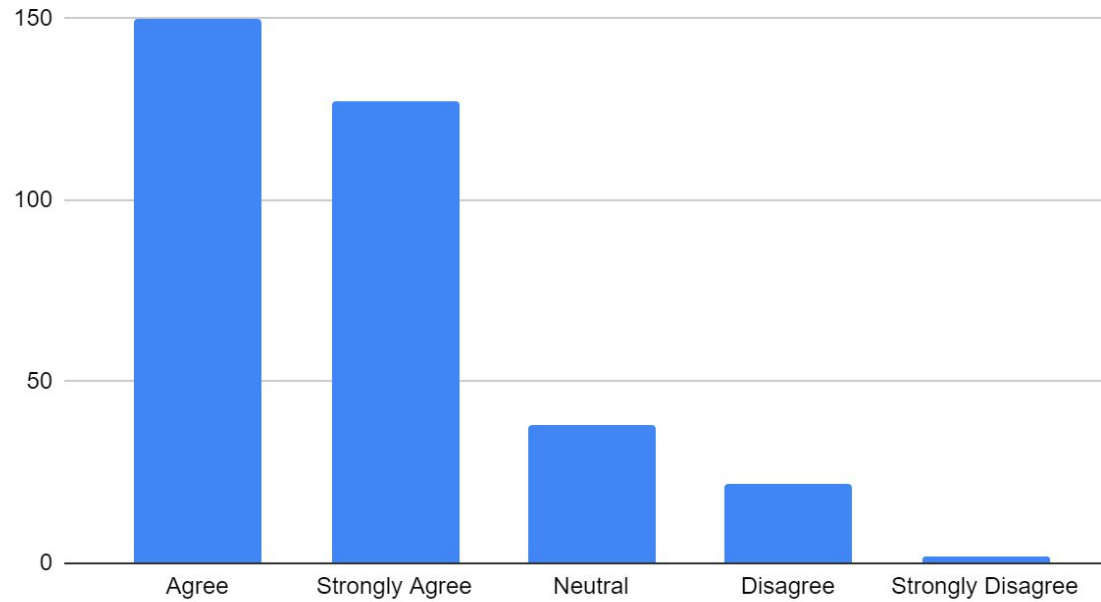

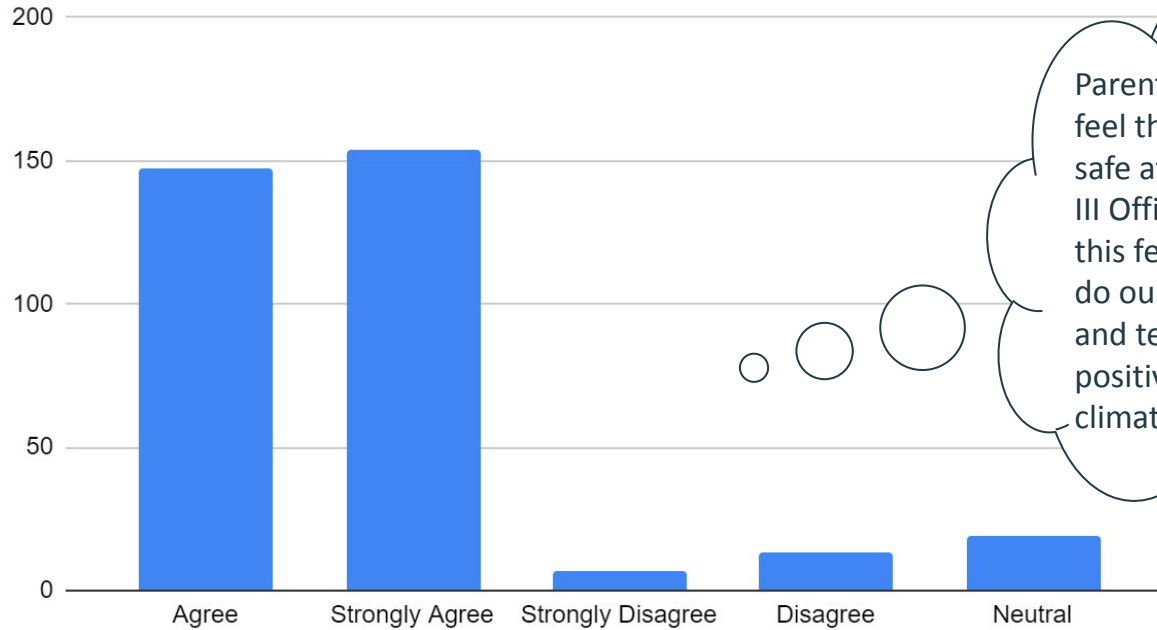

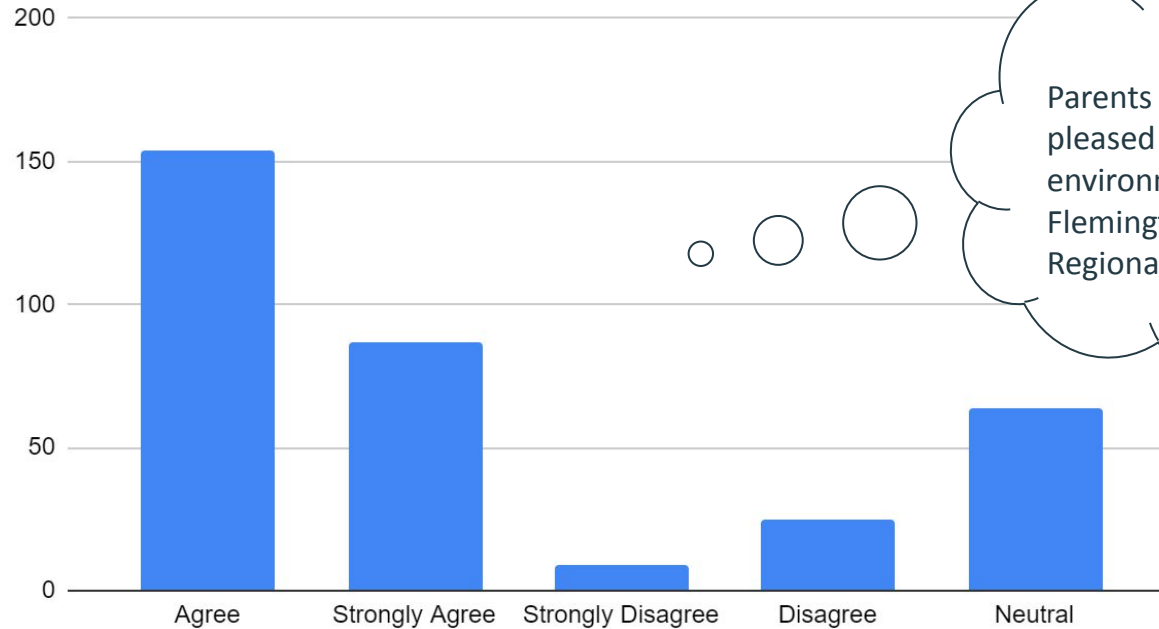

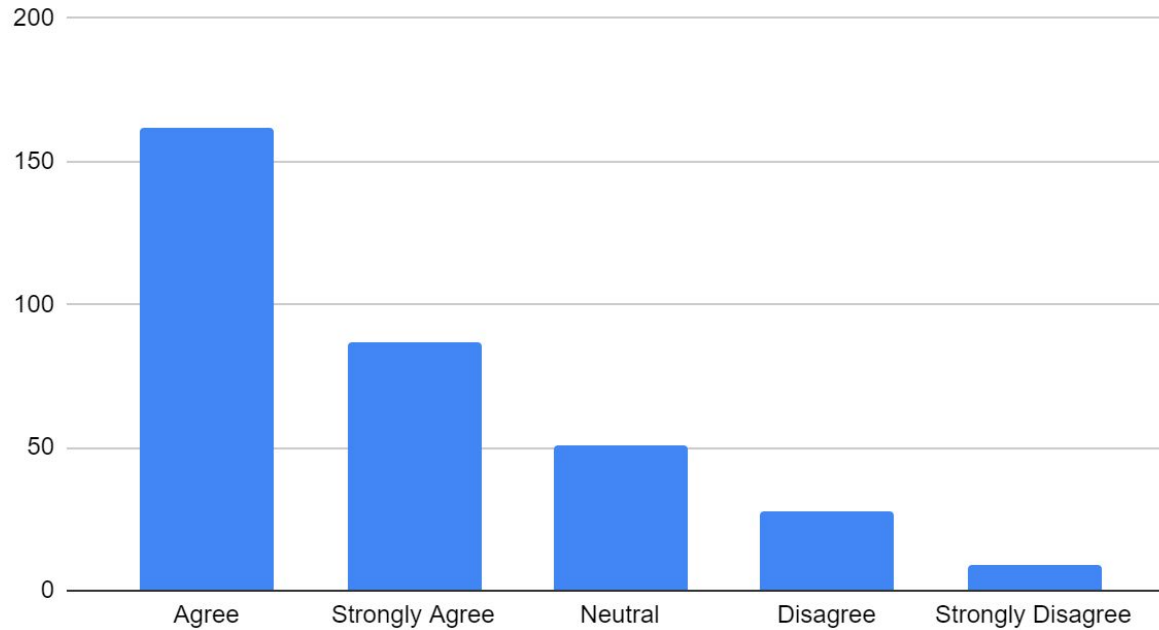

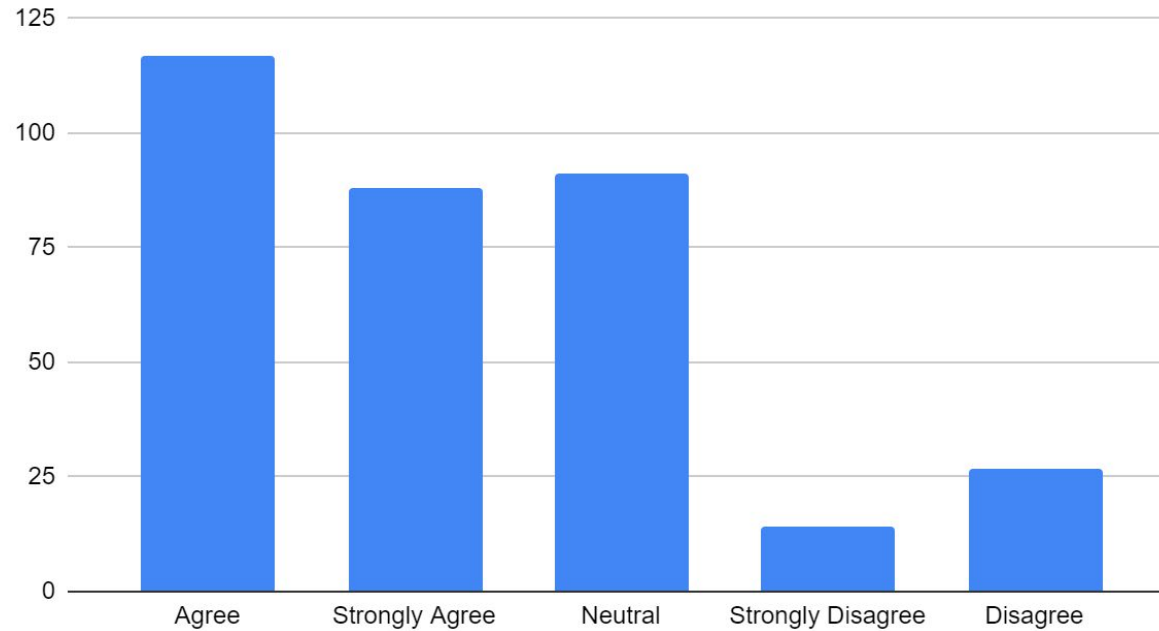

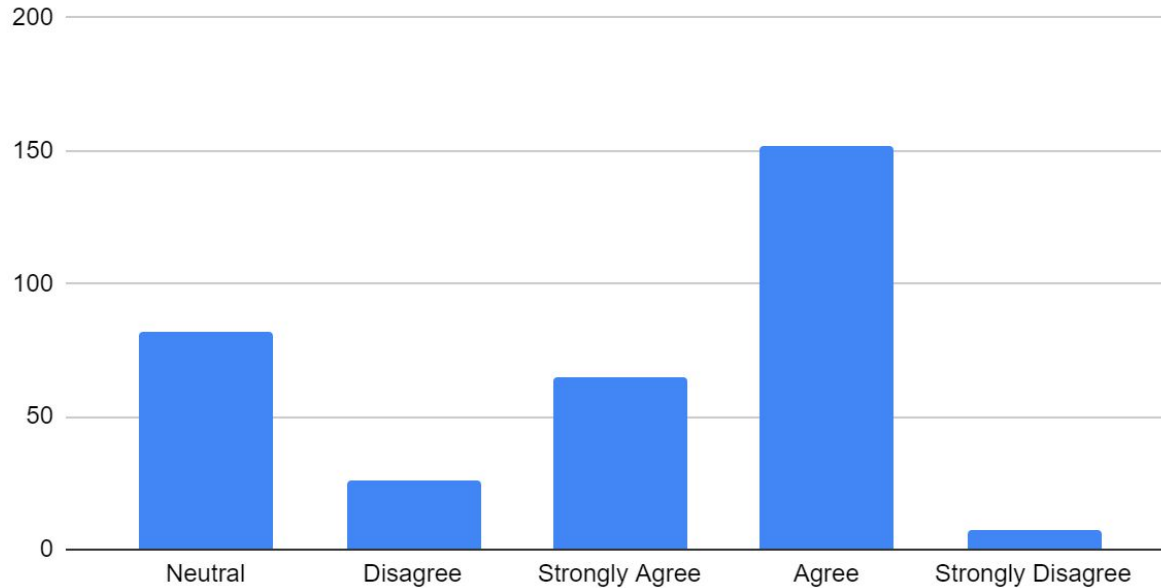

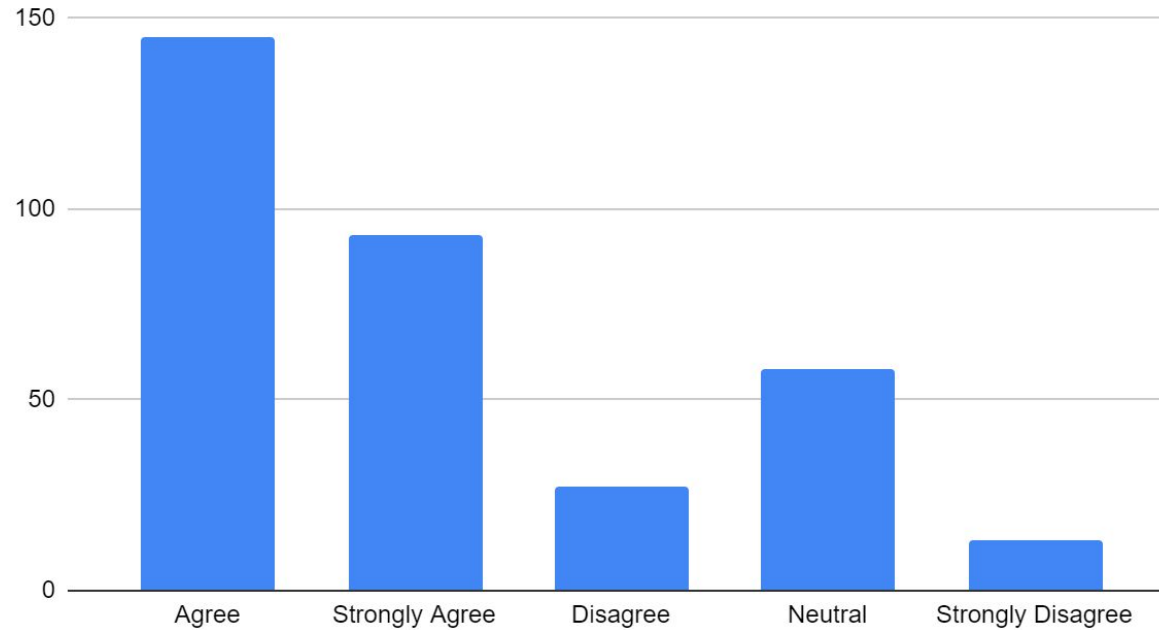

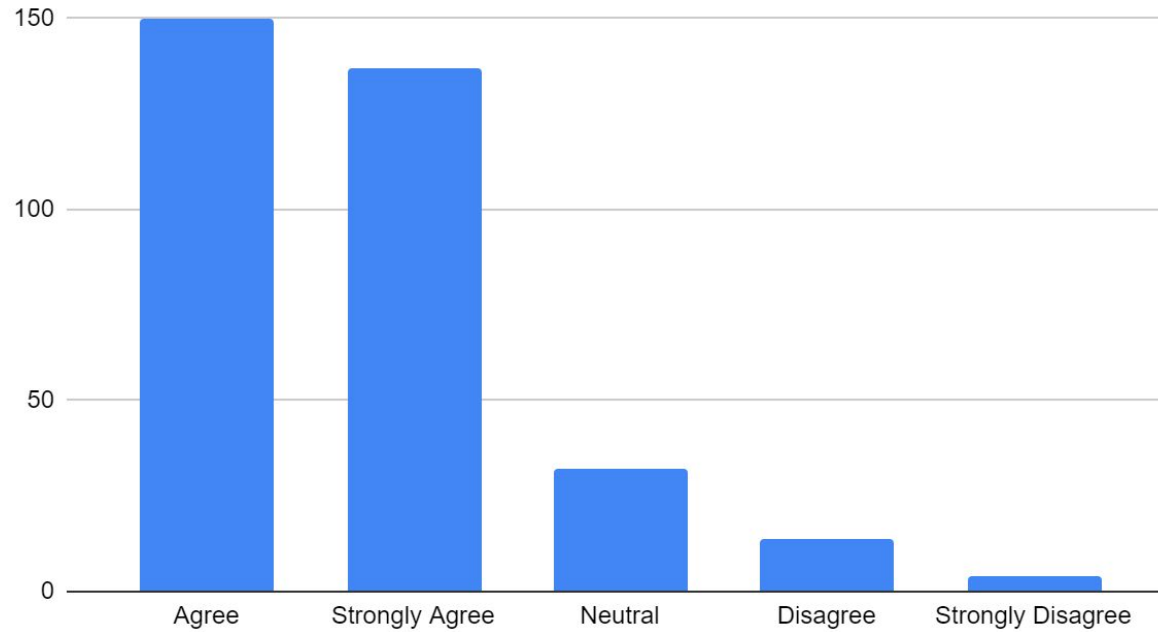

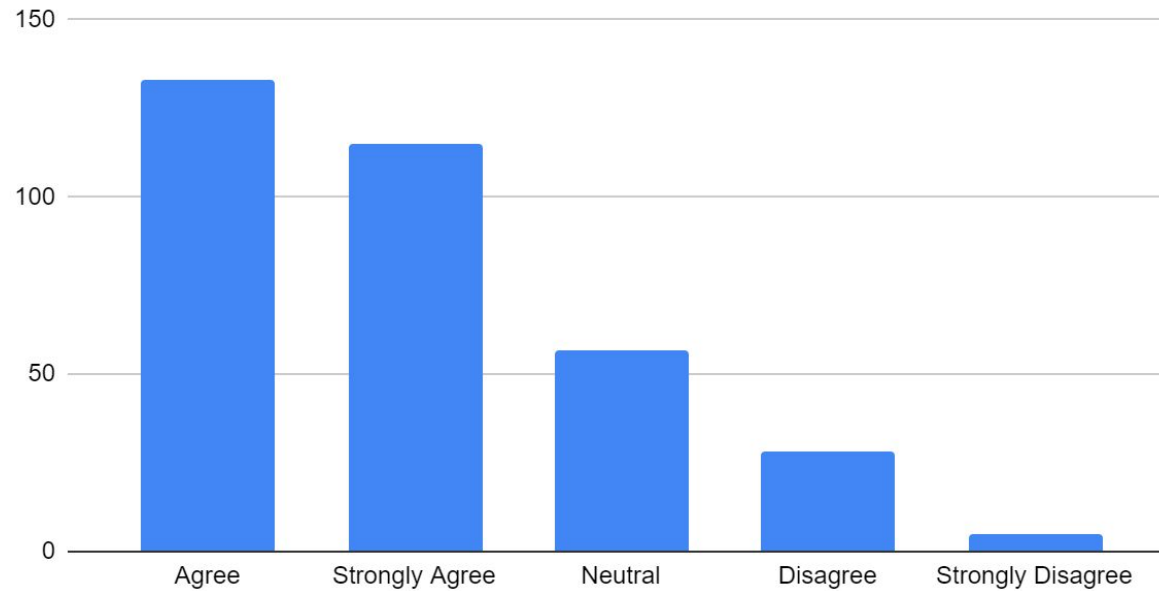

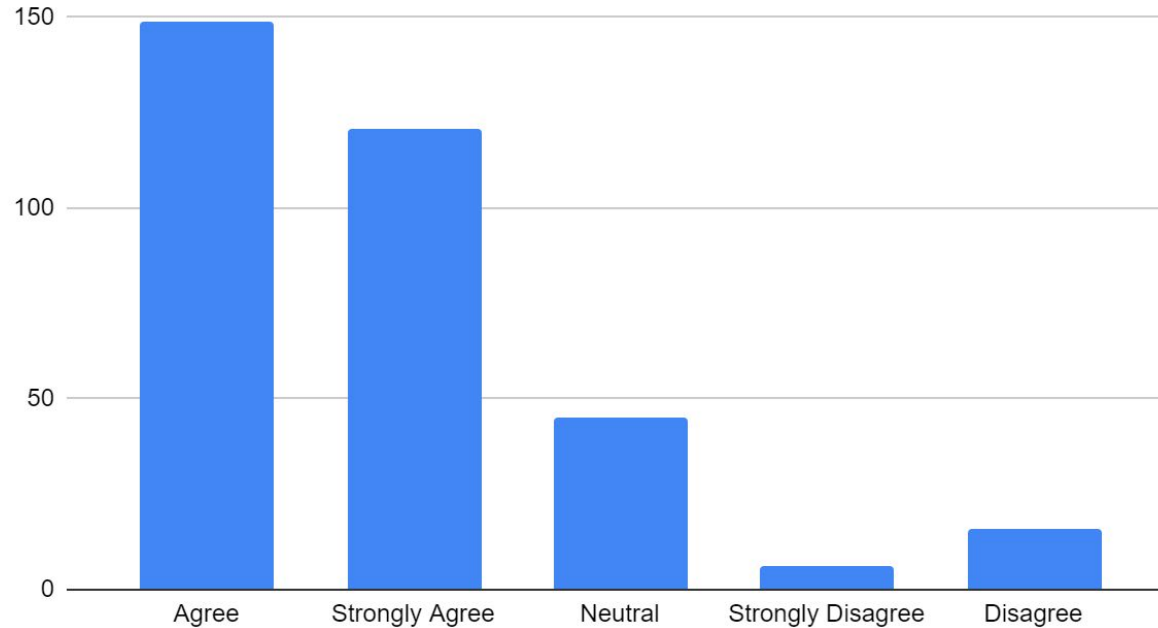

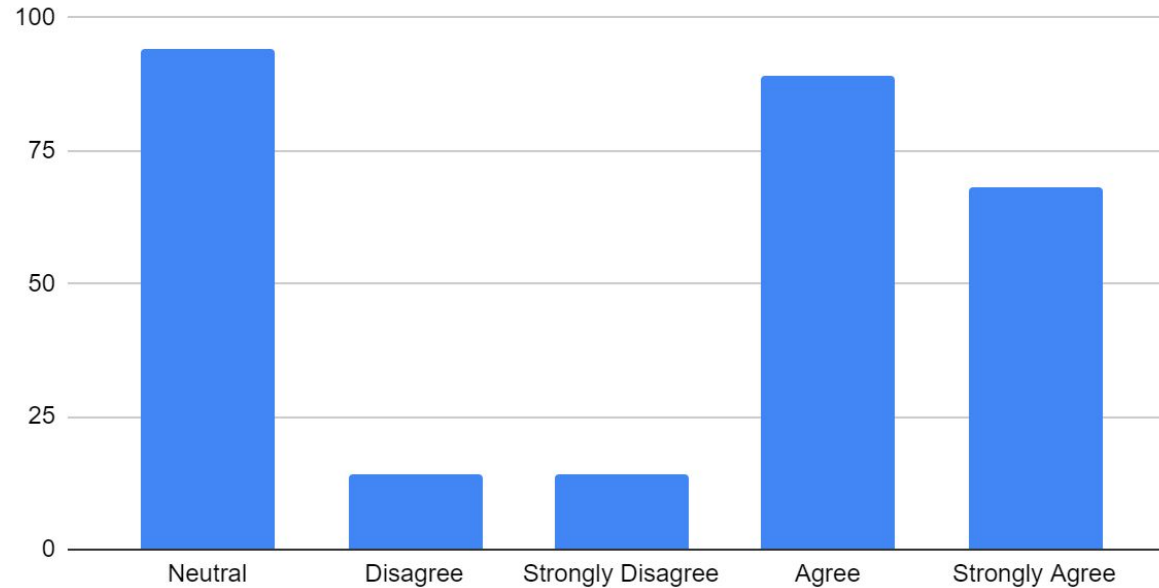

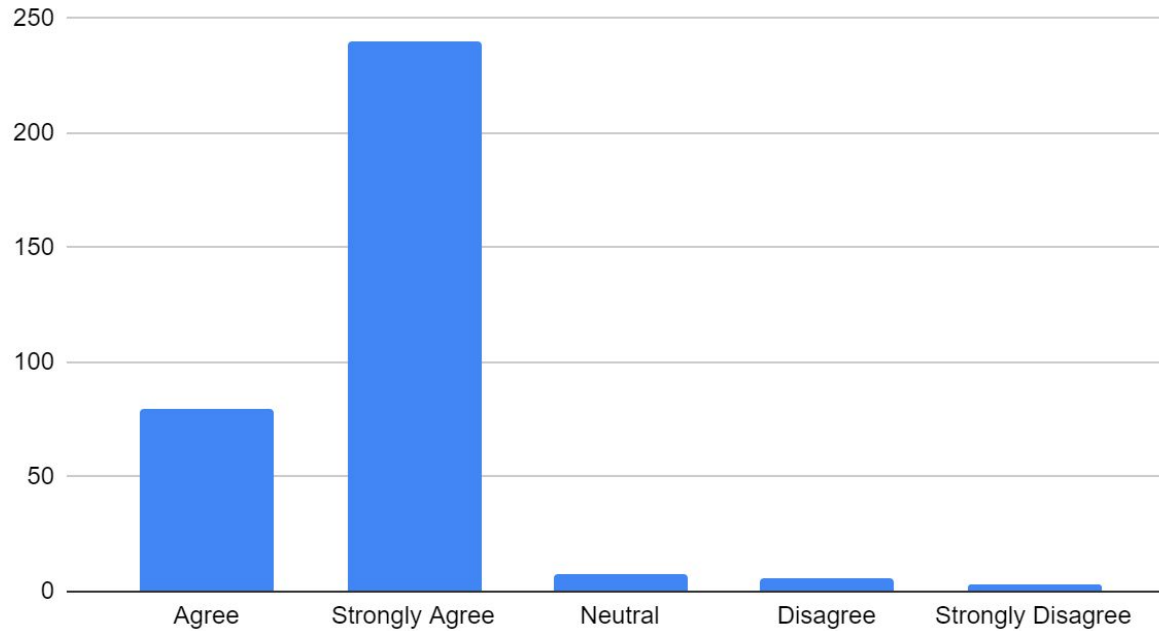

- “The Faculty, Staff, and PTO do a fabulous job communicating with the caregivers at the elementary school level”
- “I would like to see more engaging and challenging academics for those students on the higher end of the learning scale”
- “Just a massive thank you to all the staff for taking care of my child and teaching her how to be a good person in this world!! Job well done”
- “We are concerned about many reports of disrespectful student behavior in school. Some of the things my child has shared with us are appalling”
- “I'd like to see a more consistent approach to homework and reading assignments in higher grade levels. There is also a need for a more developed discipline plan and for the dress code to be enforced”
- “Teachers are excellent communicators. They are often in touch with me when my child is doing well and exceeding their expectations, but also if my child is missing the mark on an assignment or isn't completing work to the best that they can”



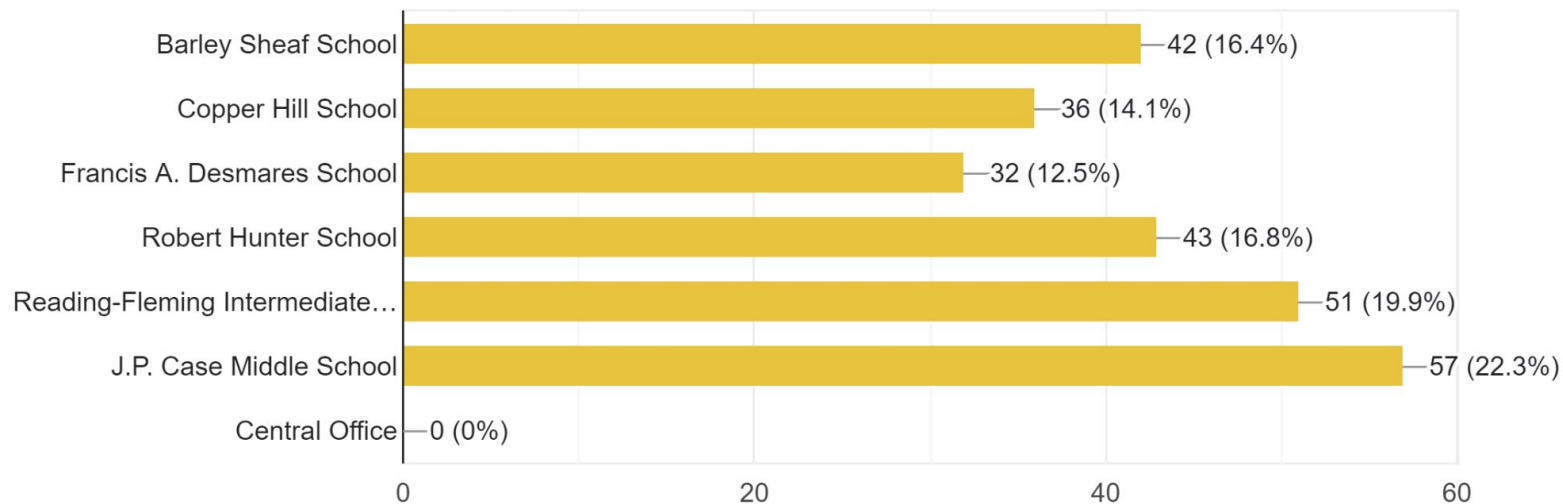

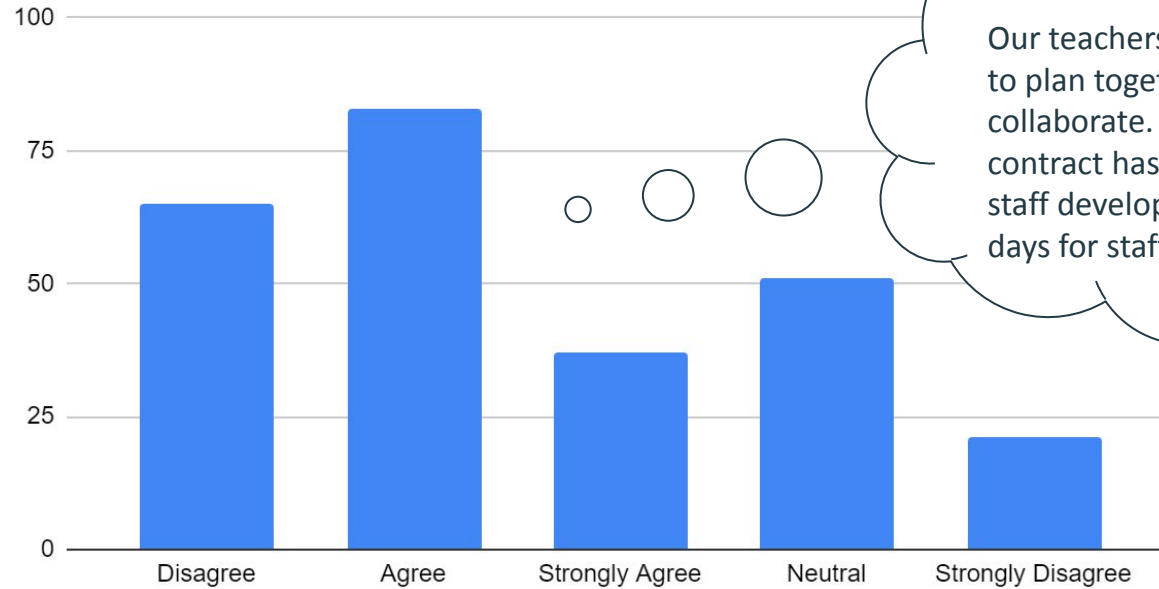

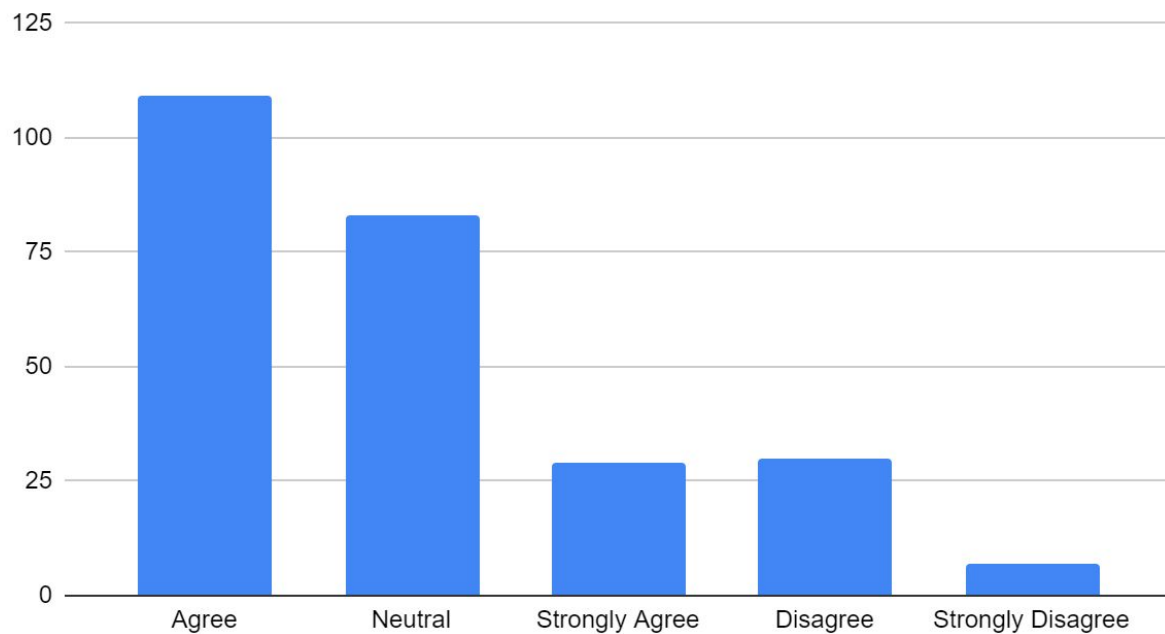
The school's schedule allows adequate time for teacher collaboration.

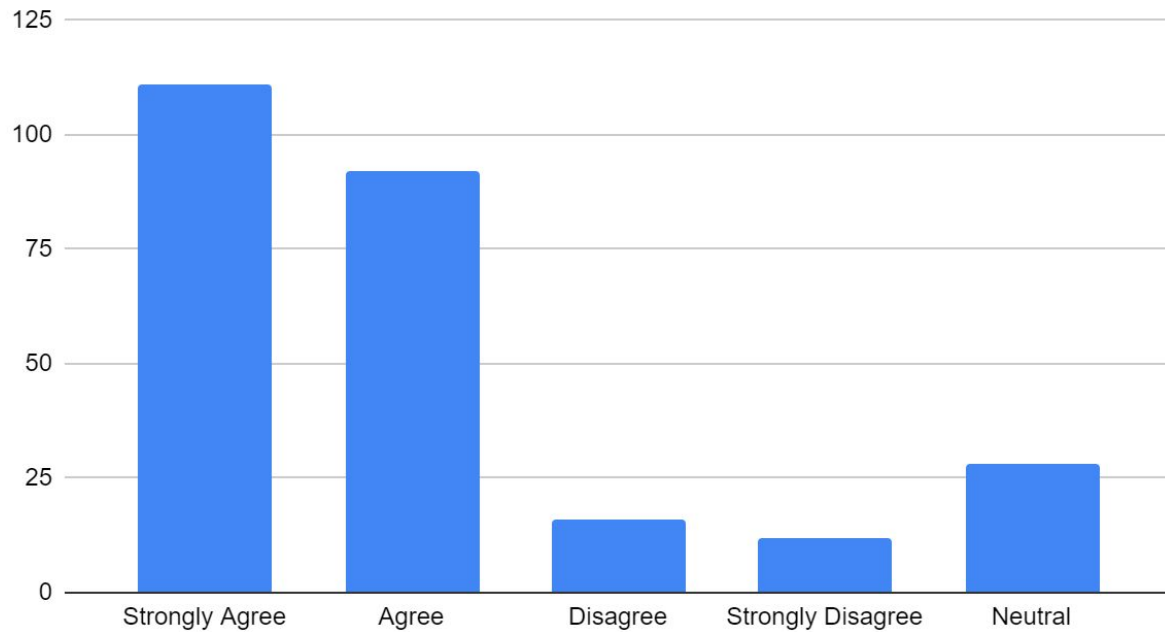

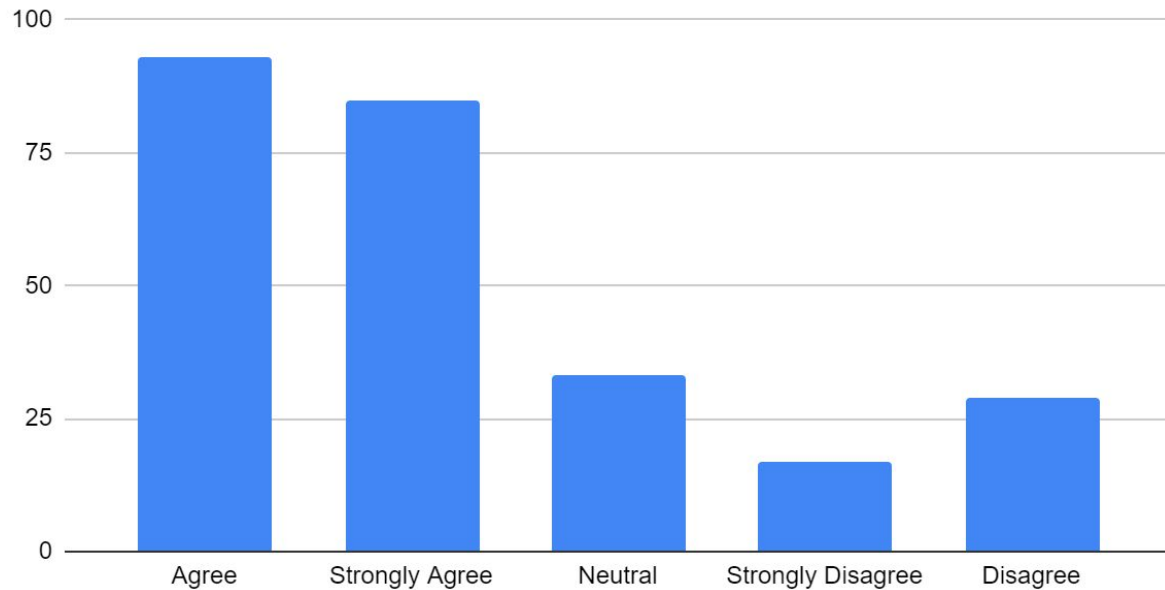

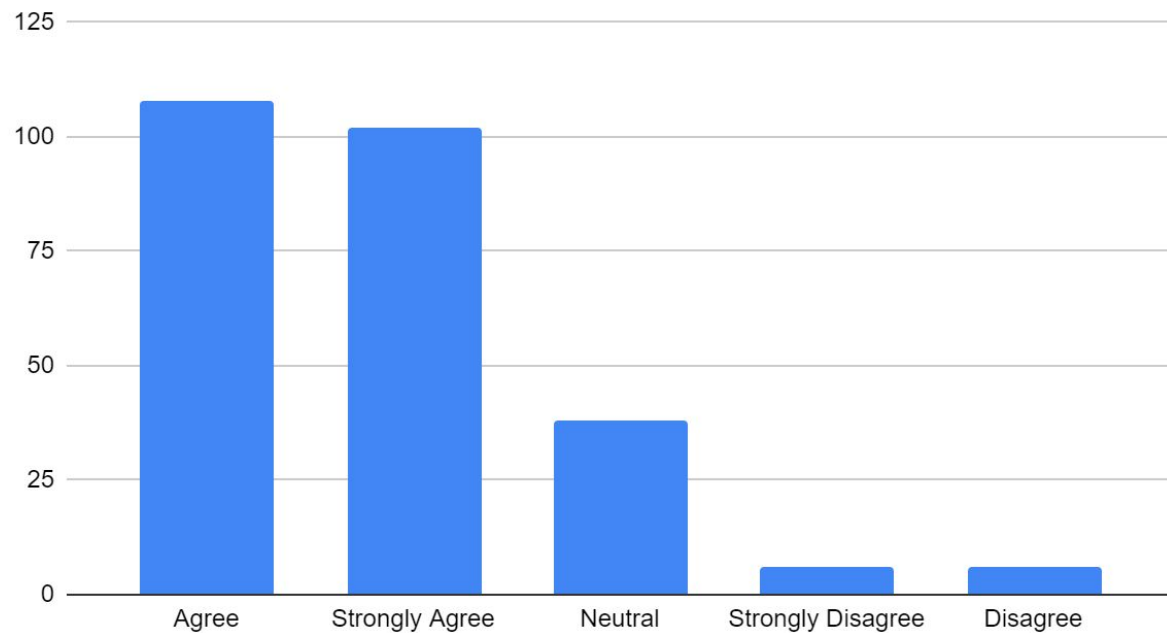

Sample Responses of Staff Comments

- "I have been impressed by the level of communication, follow through, support, creative ideas to improve the school and overall leadership this administration has provided"
- "Our school desperately needs a discipline policy with clear expectations and clear consequences outlined"
- "Decisions are made by administration without adequate input from teachers"
- "I'm very happy with the community at my school. Our school finally has two administrators that are vested in our students, staff, and community. It's a great place to work, learn, and grow"
- "I think that students' respect for teachers have changed since Covid. Parents do not back up teachers when they are called home for discipline reasons. I think we need stronger guidelines on what happens to students when they misbehave AND we need ISS and detention after school"
- "We struggle with family vacations during instructional time. These vacations are disruptive to a child's progress and classroom dynamics"
- "There needs to be more emphasis made to parents about how important their role is to their child's success"

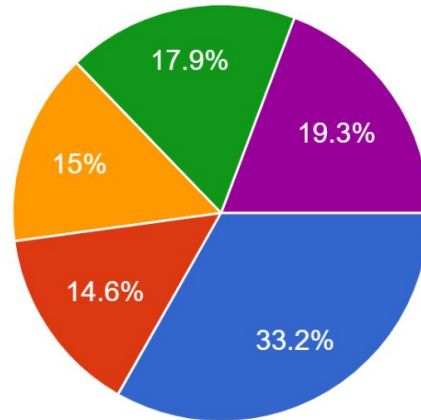

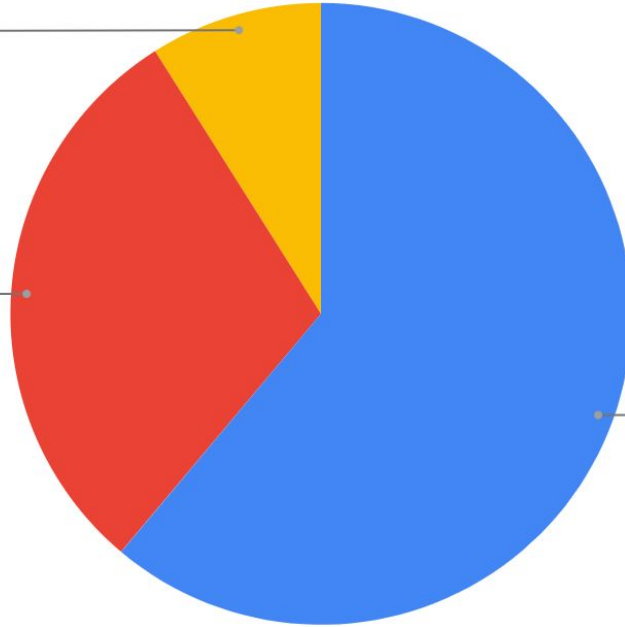

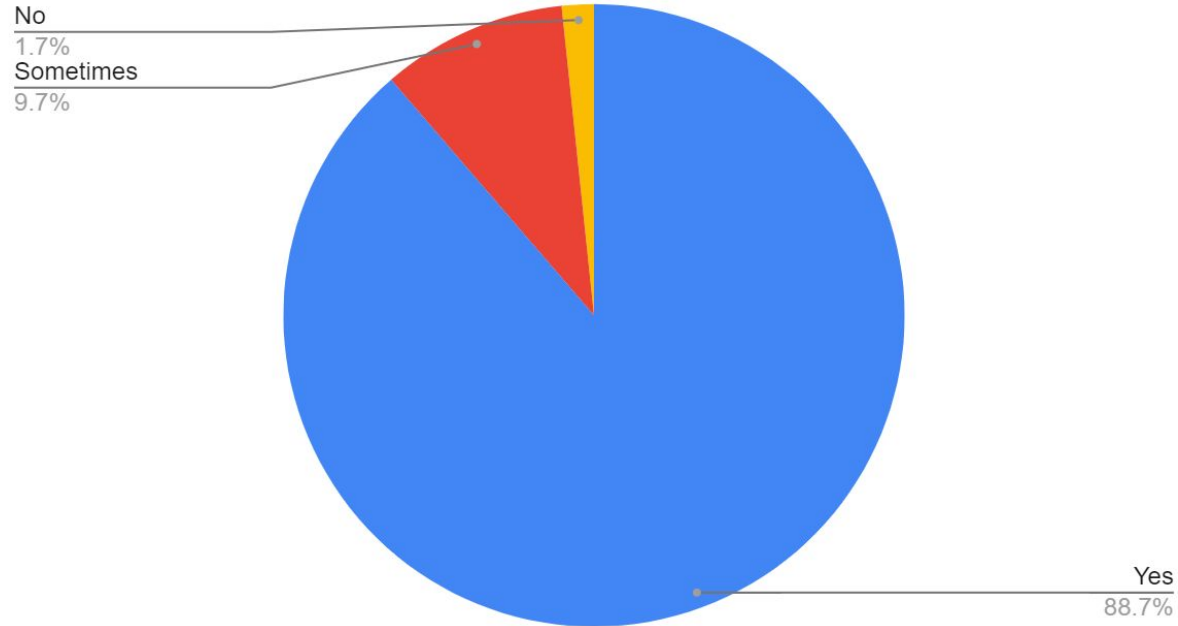

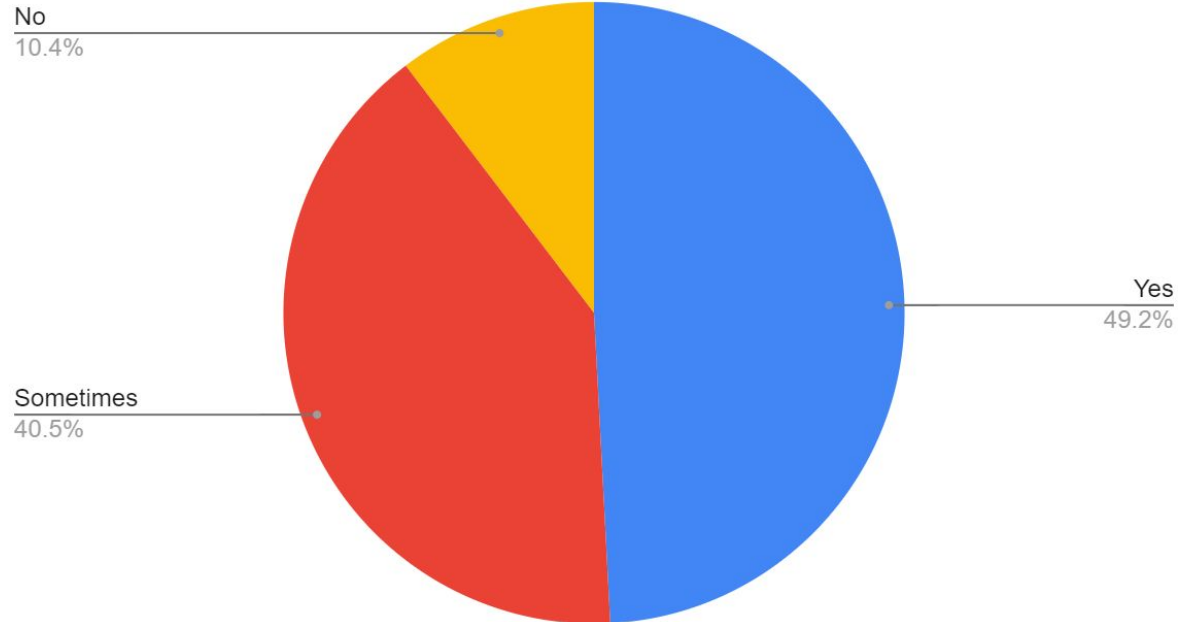

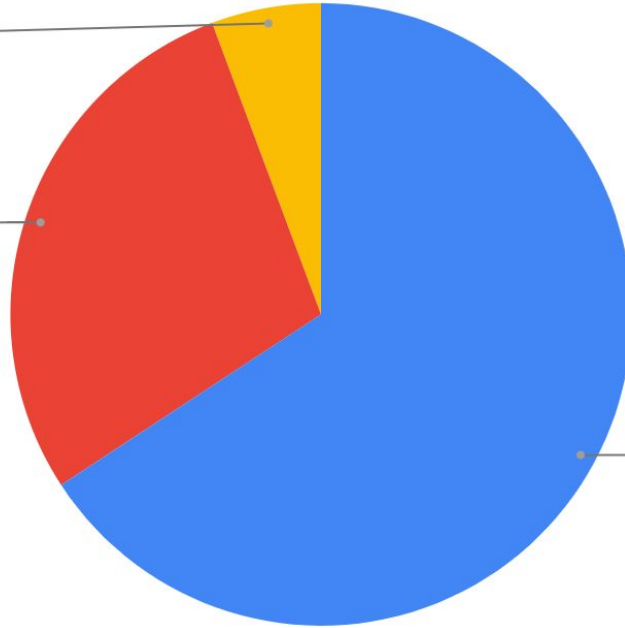

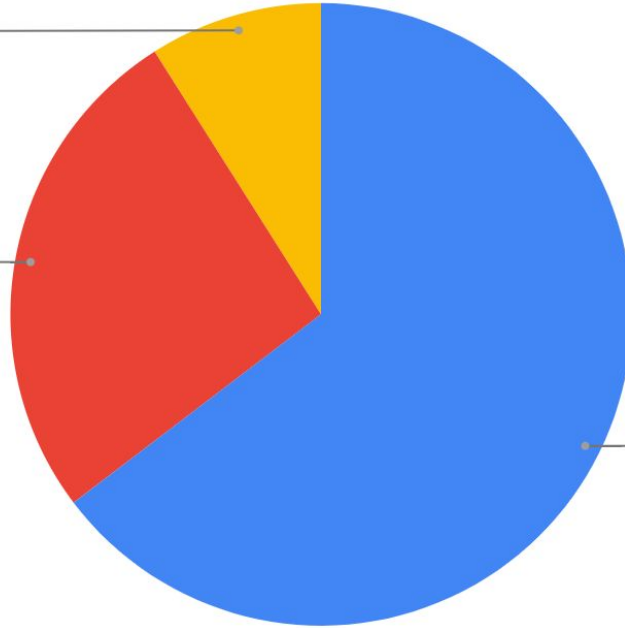

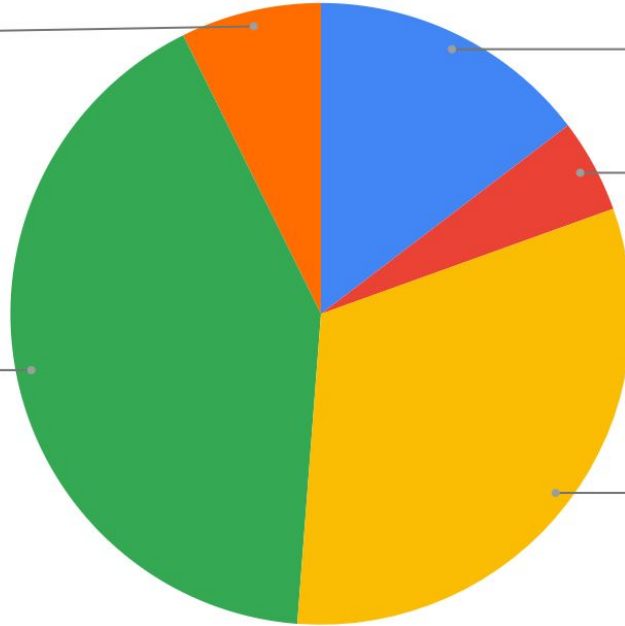

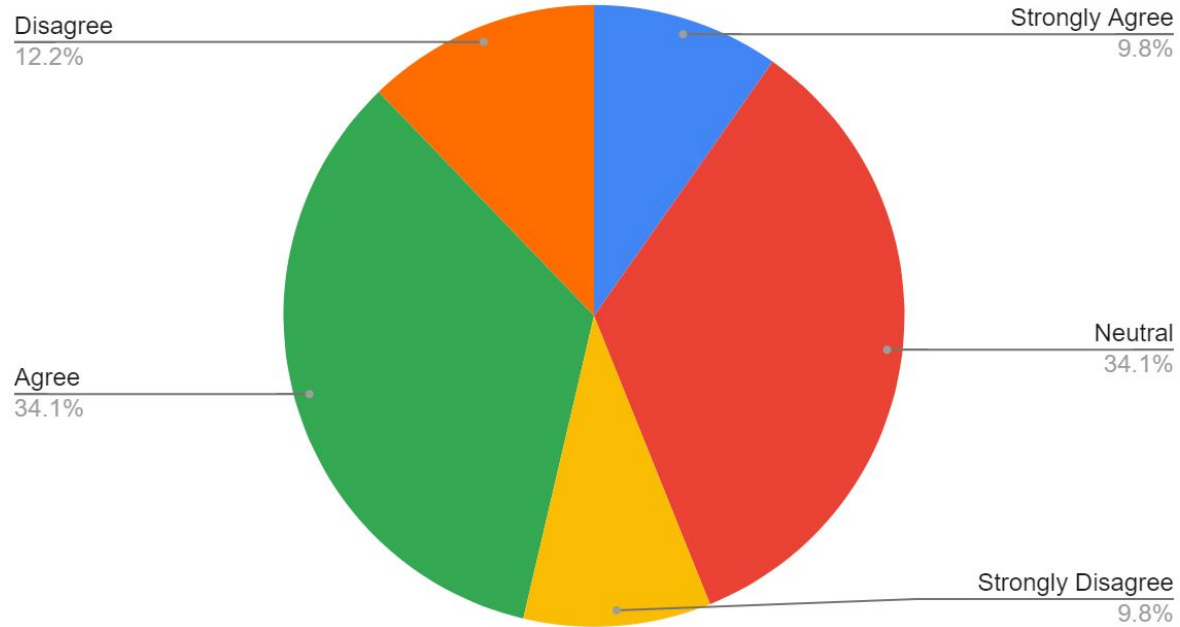

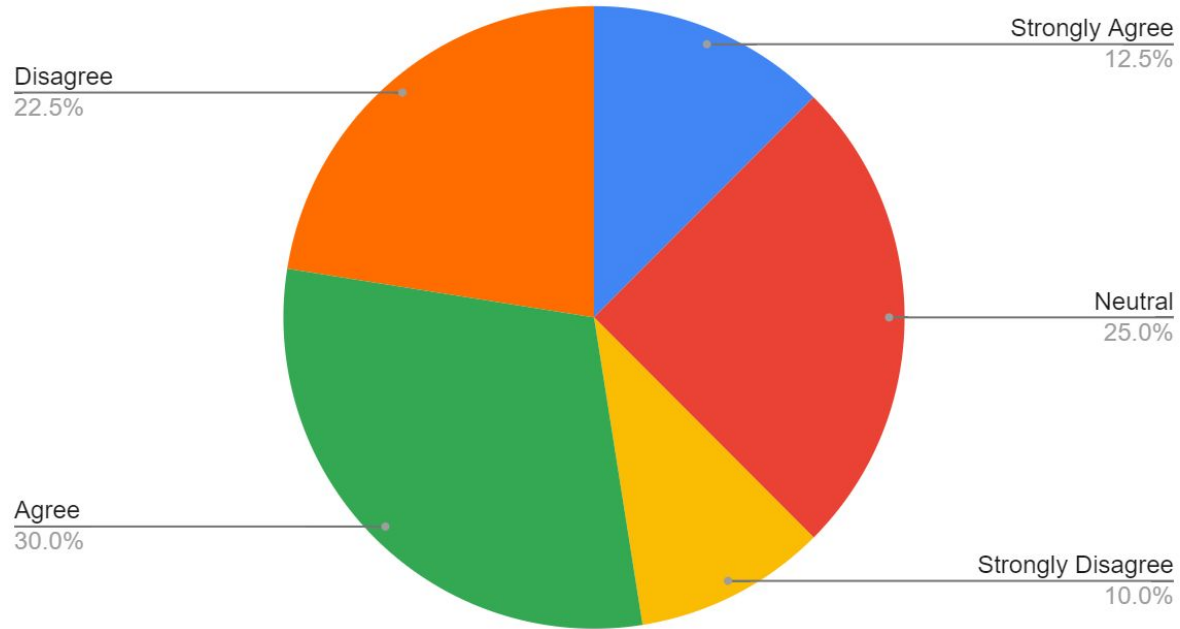

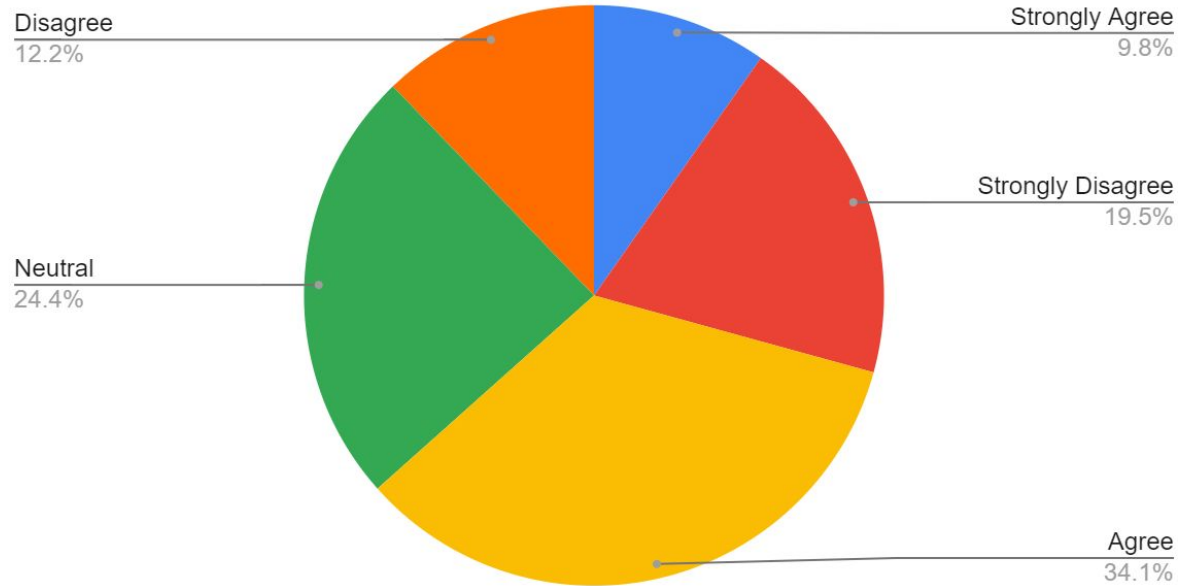

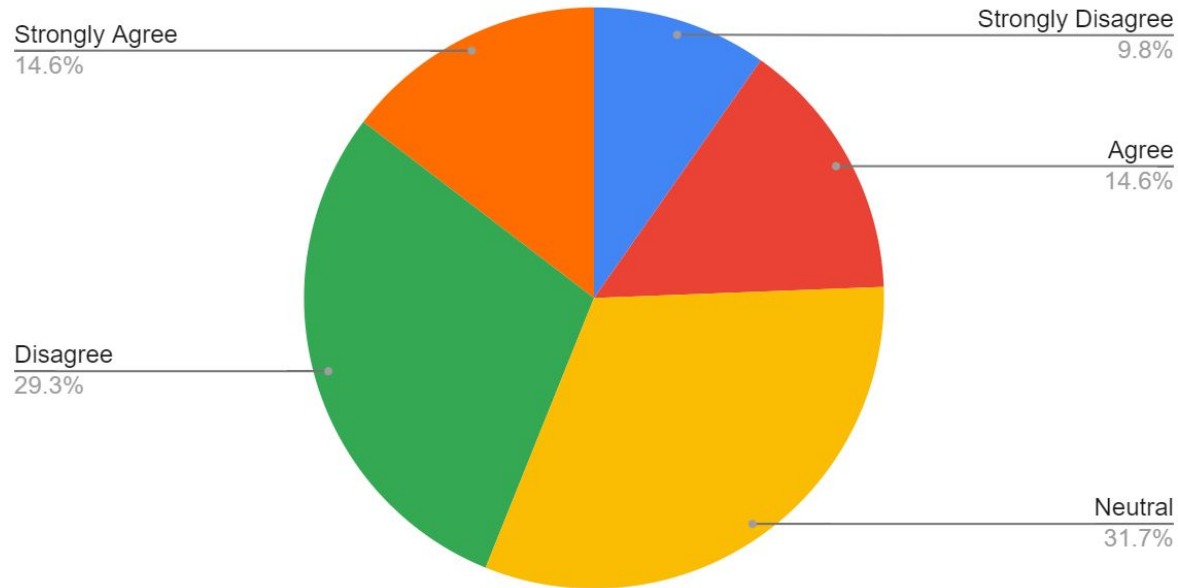

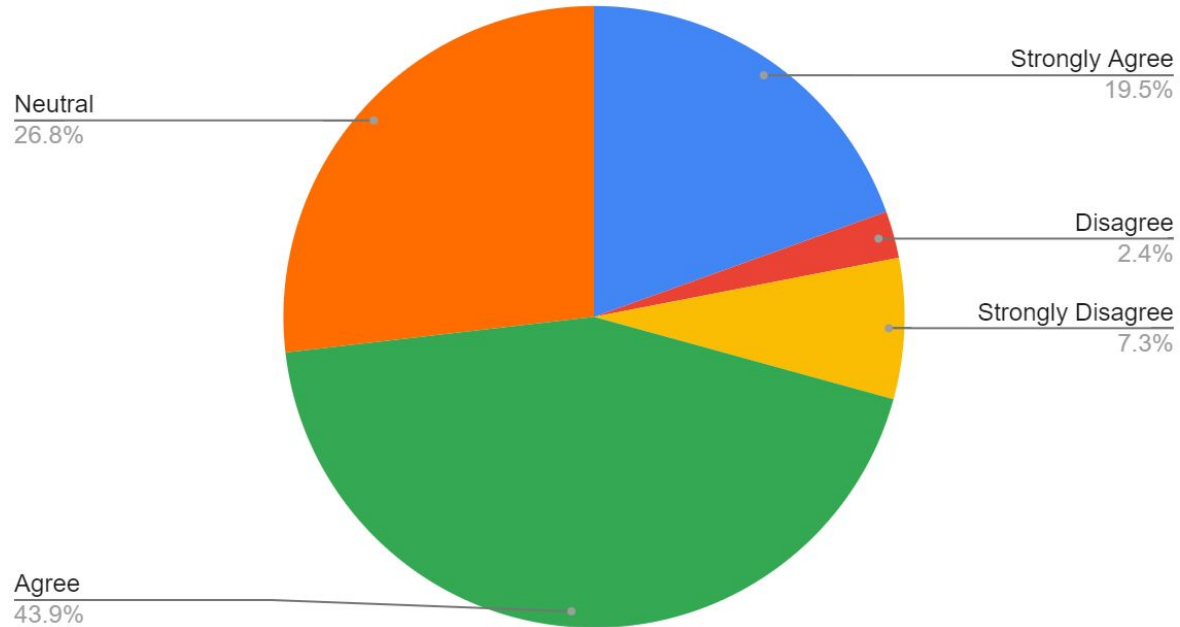
