NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM



New Jersey Assessment Programs - History

- 2003-2014 - New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge (NJASK)
- 2015-2018 - Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC)
- 2019 to present - New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) implemented
 - Spring 2019 - 1st year of NJSLA implementation
 - Spring 2020 - NJSLA cancelled due to the pandemic
 - Spring 2021 - NJSLA cancelled with NJDOE agreement to implement Fall Start Strong assessment
 - Spring 2022 - 2nd year of NJSLA implementation
 - Spring 2023 - 3rd year of NJSLA implementation
 - Spring 2024 - 4th year of NJSLA implementation

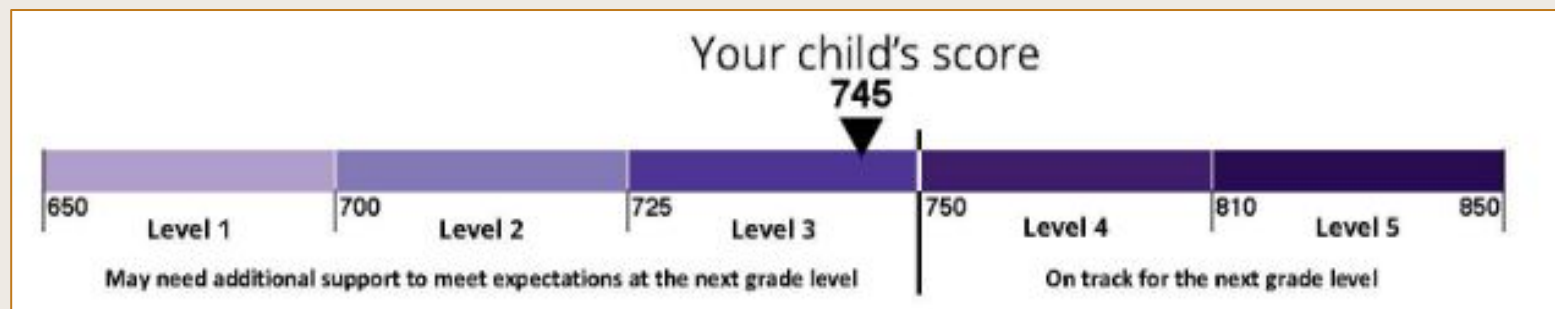


NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

New Jersey Student Learning Assessment – 2024 Administration

- Who is tested?
 - All students in grades 3-8 must take the NJSLA.
 - A small percentage of our students qualify for the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) assessment designed specifically for the severely cognitively impaired.
 - ESL students who arrived in the US after June 1 may be exempted from ELA testing.
- Testing Occurred in May 2024
 - ELA Grade 3 – two units over two days; each 75 minutes
 - ELA Grades 4-8 – two units over two days; each 90 minutes
 - Math Grade 3-8 – three units over three days; each 60 minutes
 - Algebra 1/Geometry – two units over two days; each 90 minutes
 - Science 5 & 8 – four units over 2 days; each unit 45 minutes
- Test Format
 - Unless otherwise specified by in a child's Individual Education Program (IEP), all testing occurs digitally.
 - ESL students may be offered the NJSLA Mathematics test in Spanish.

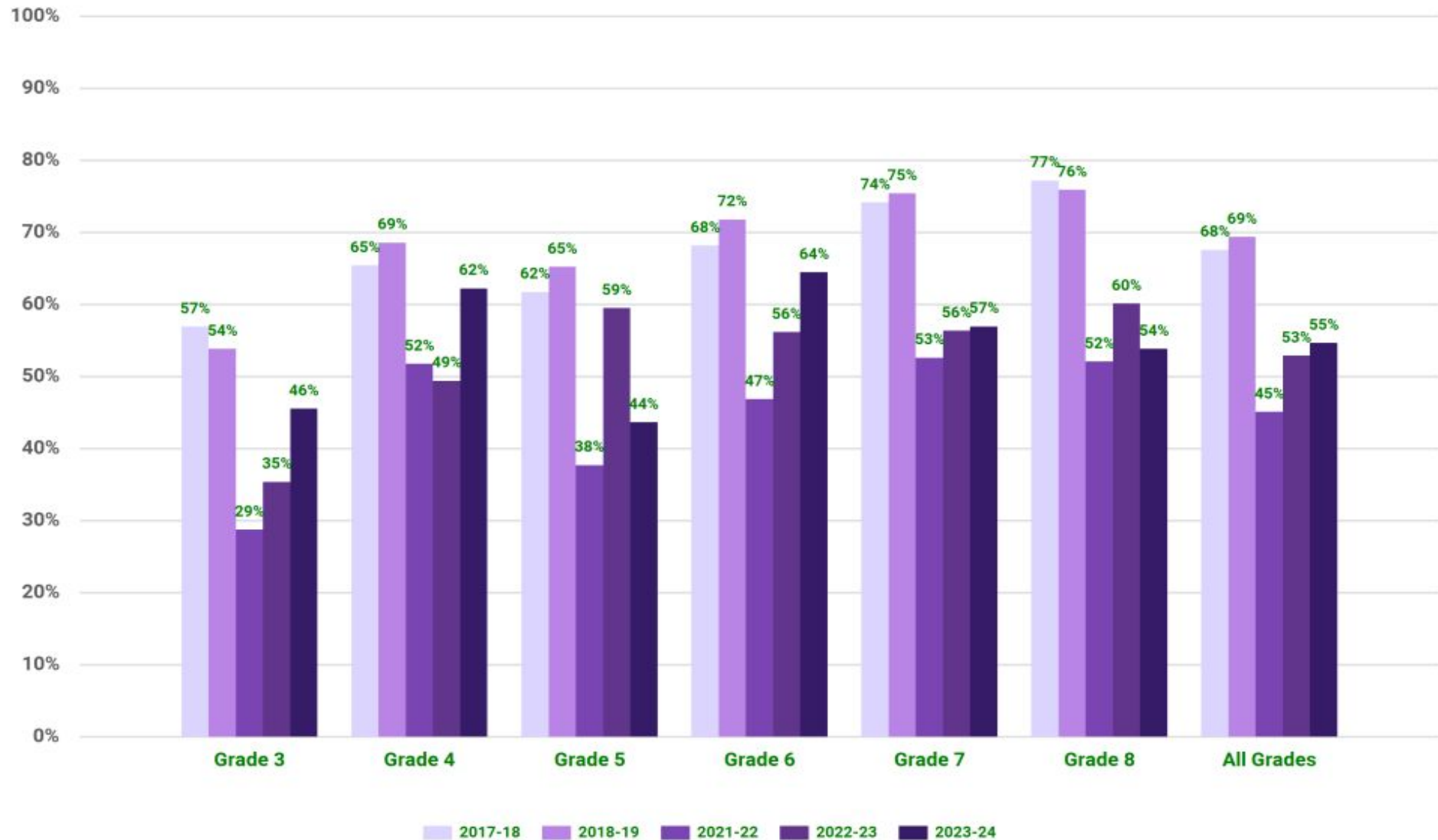

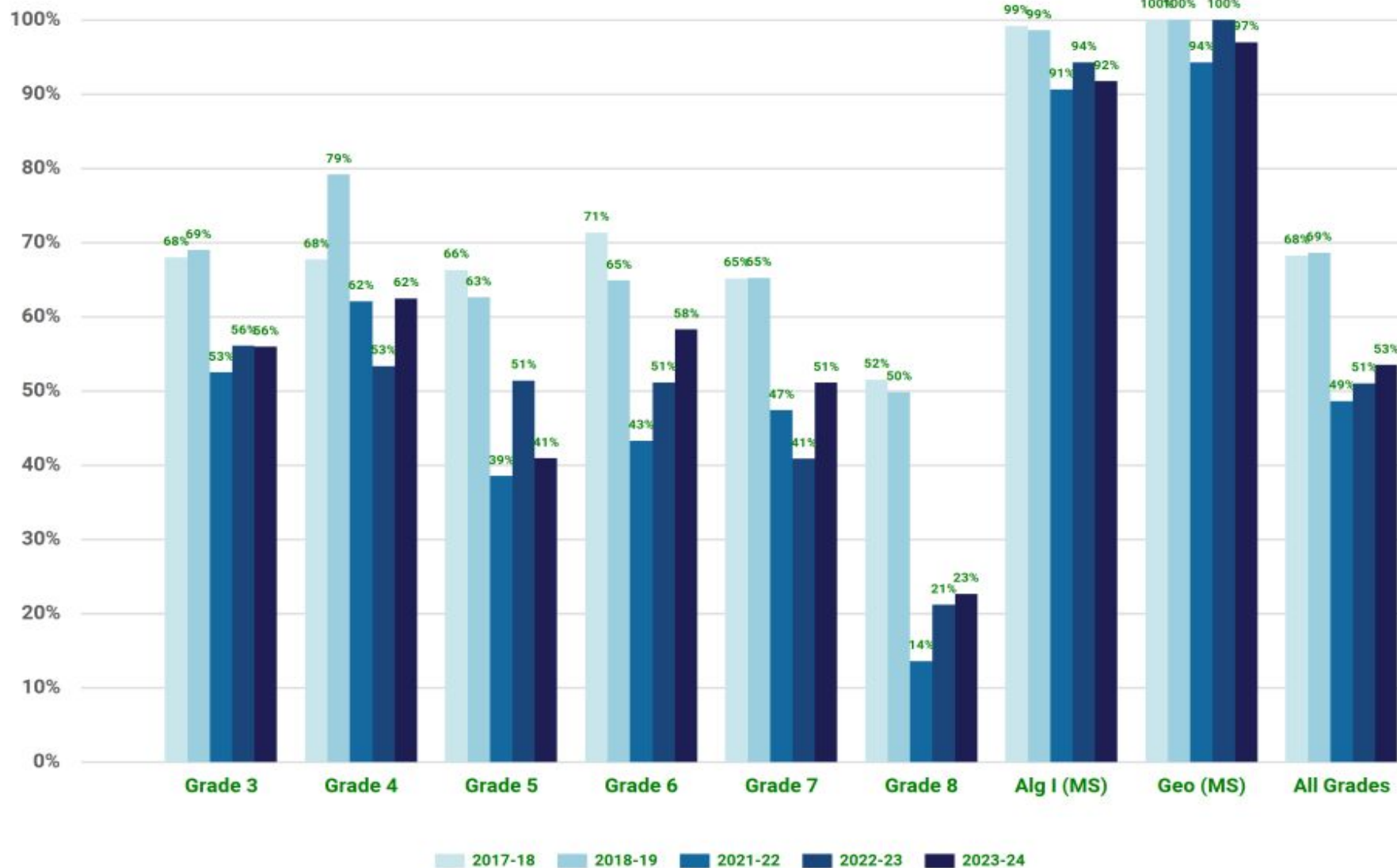

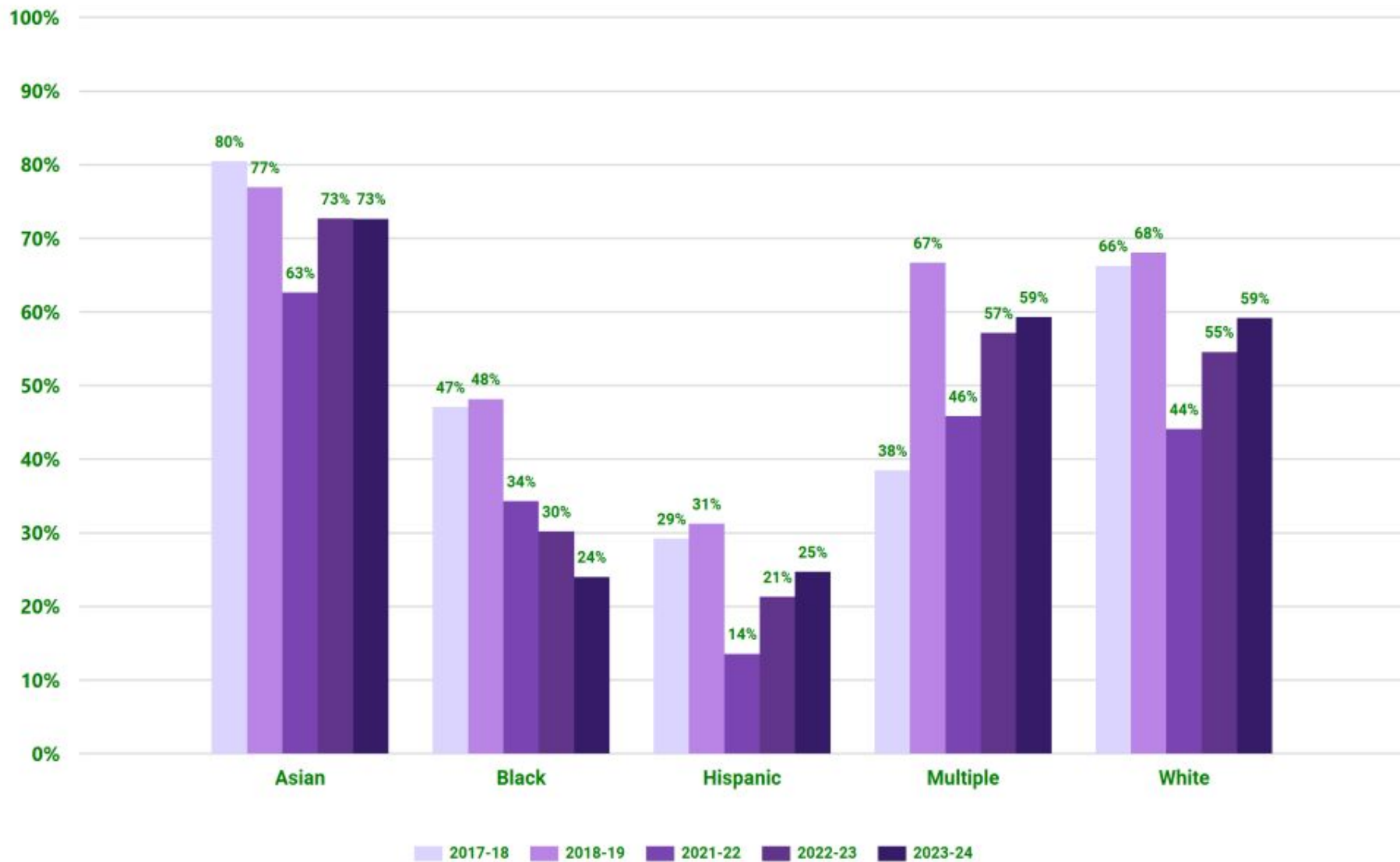

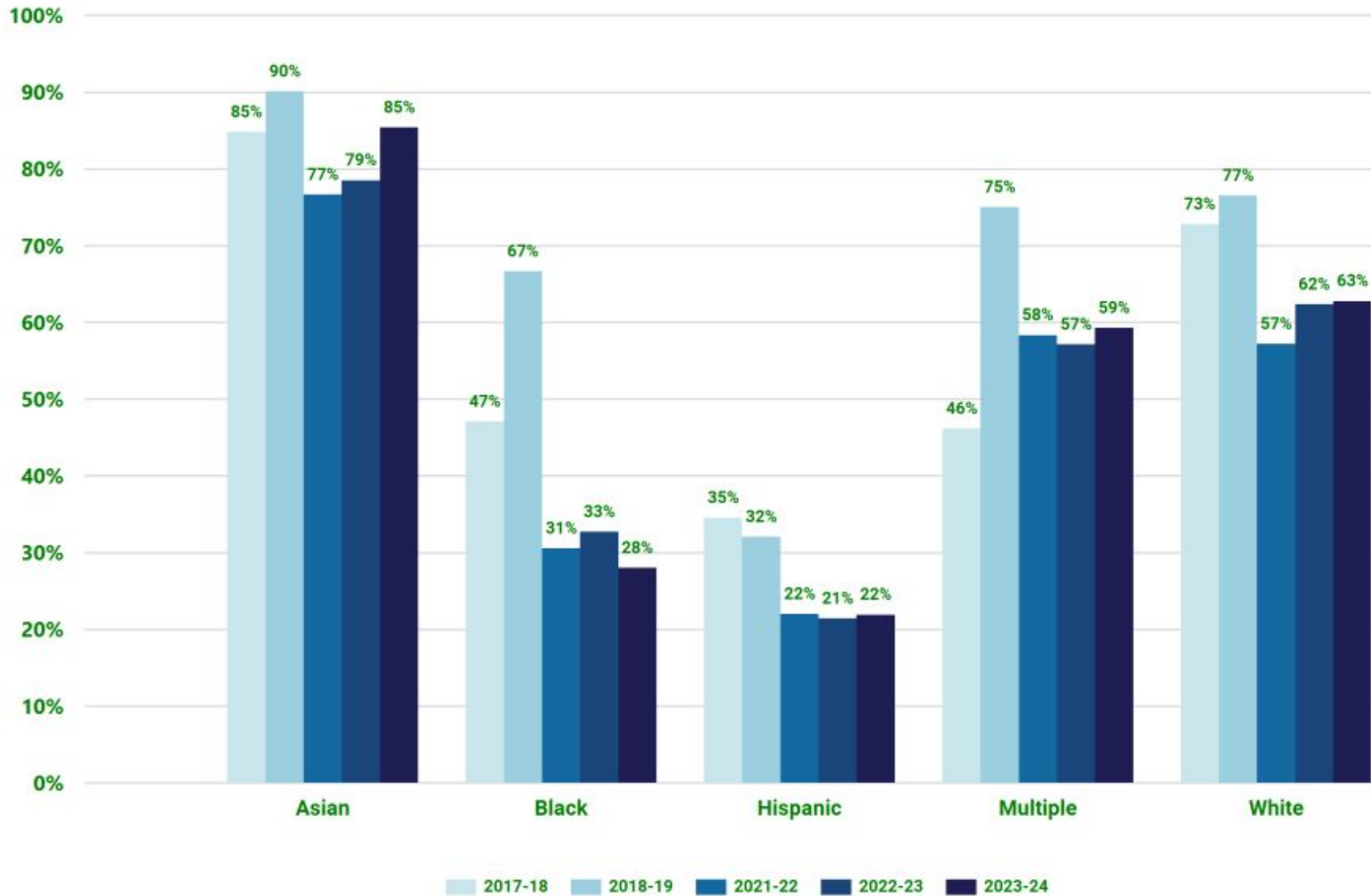
Proficiency by Race

% Meeting + Exceeding (ELA G3-G5)



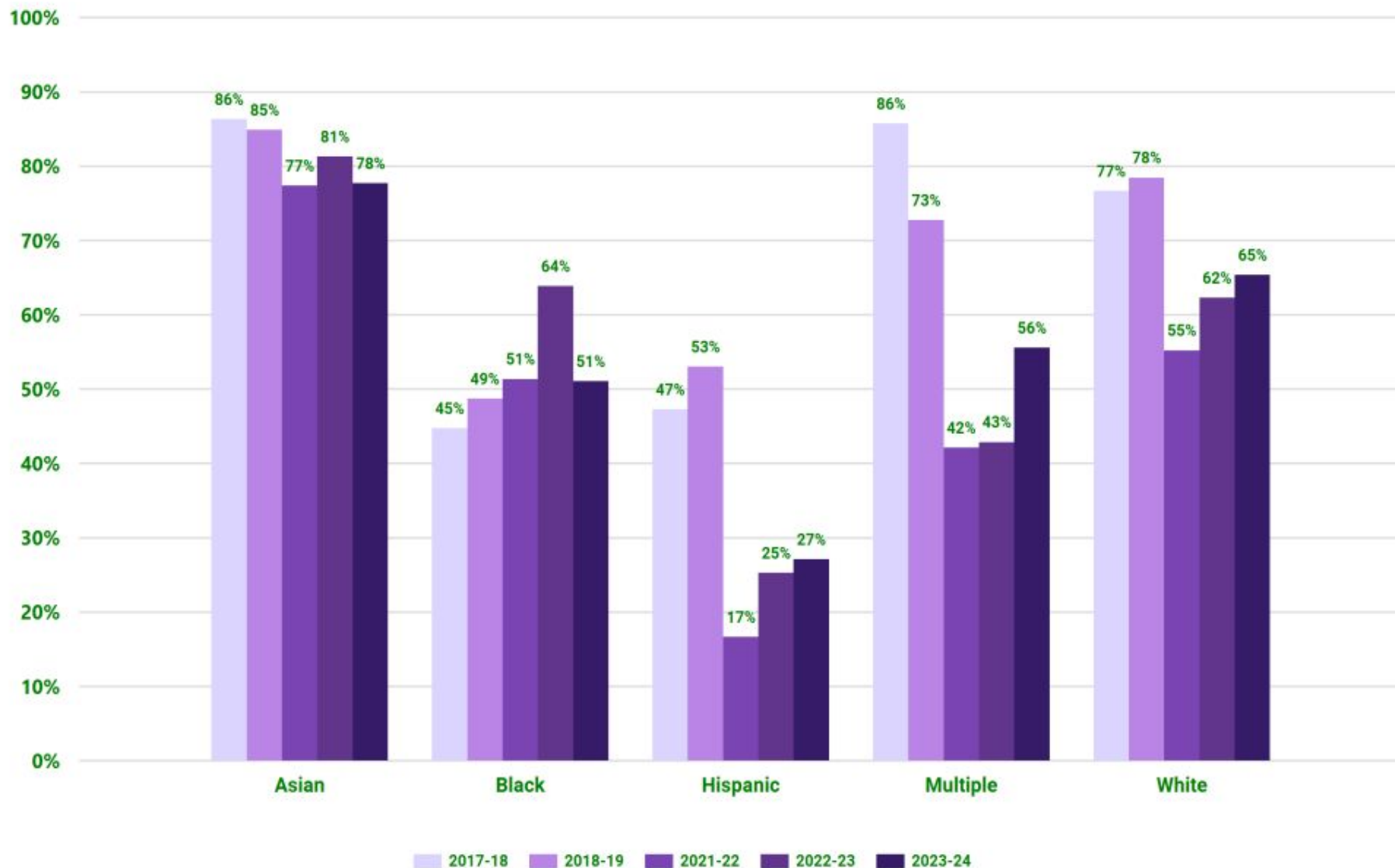

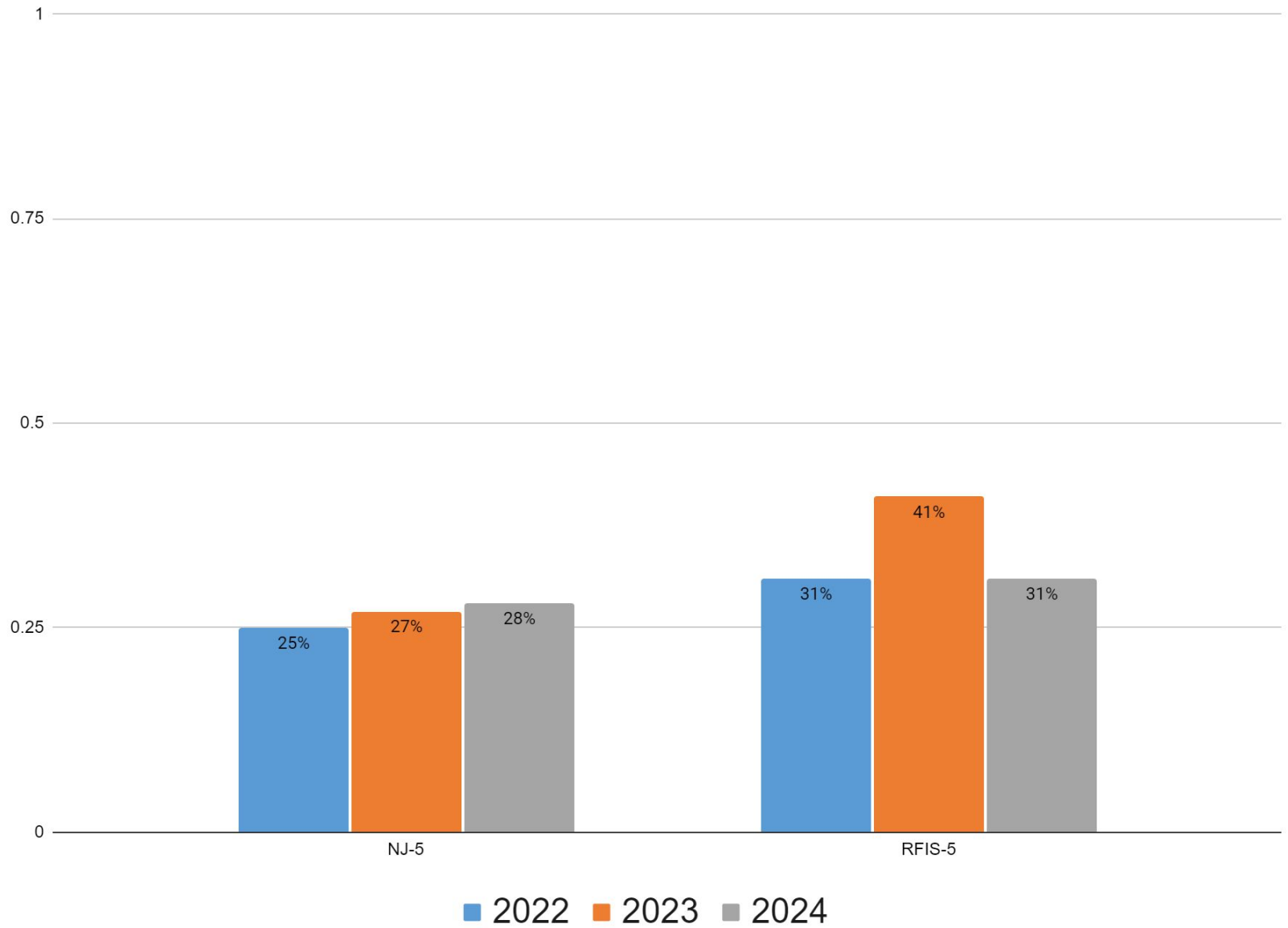

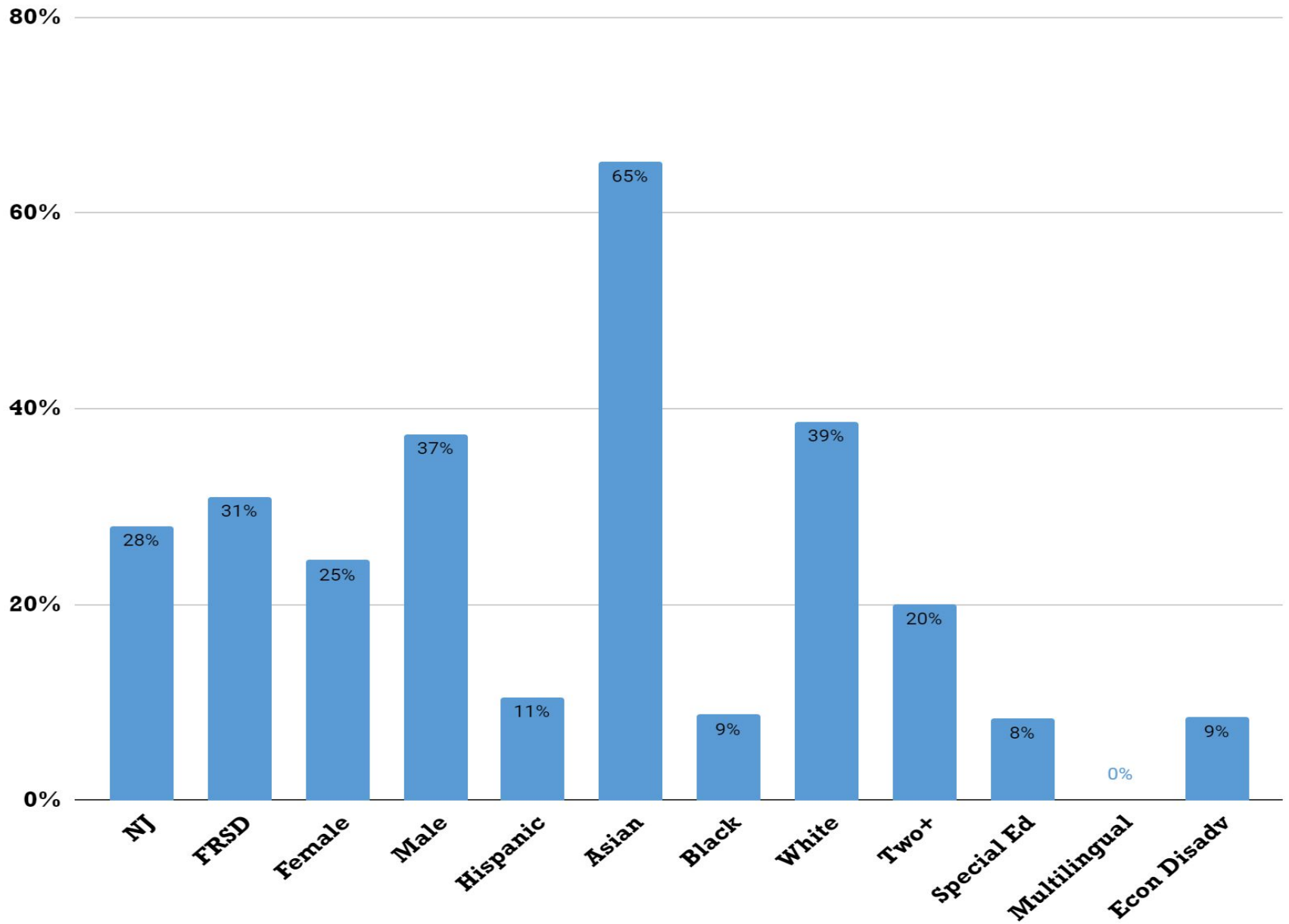

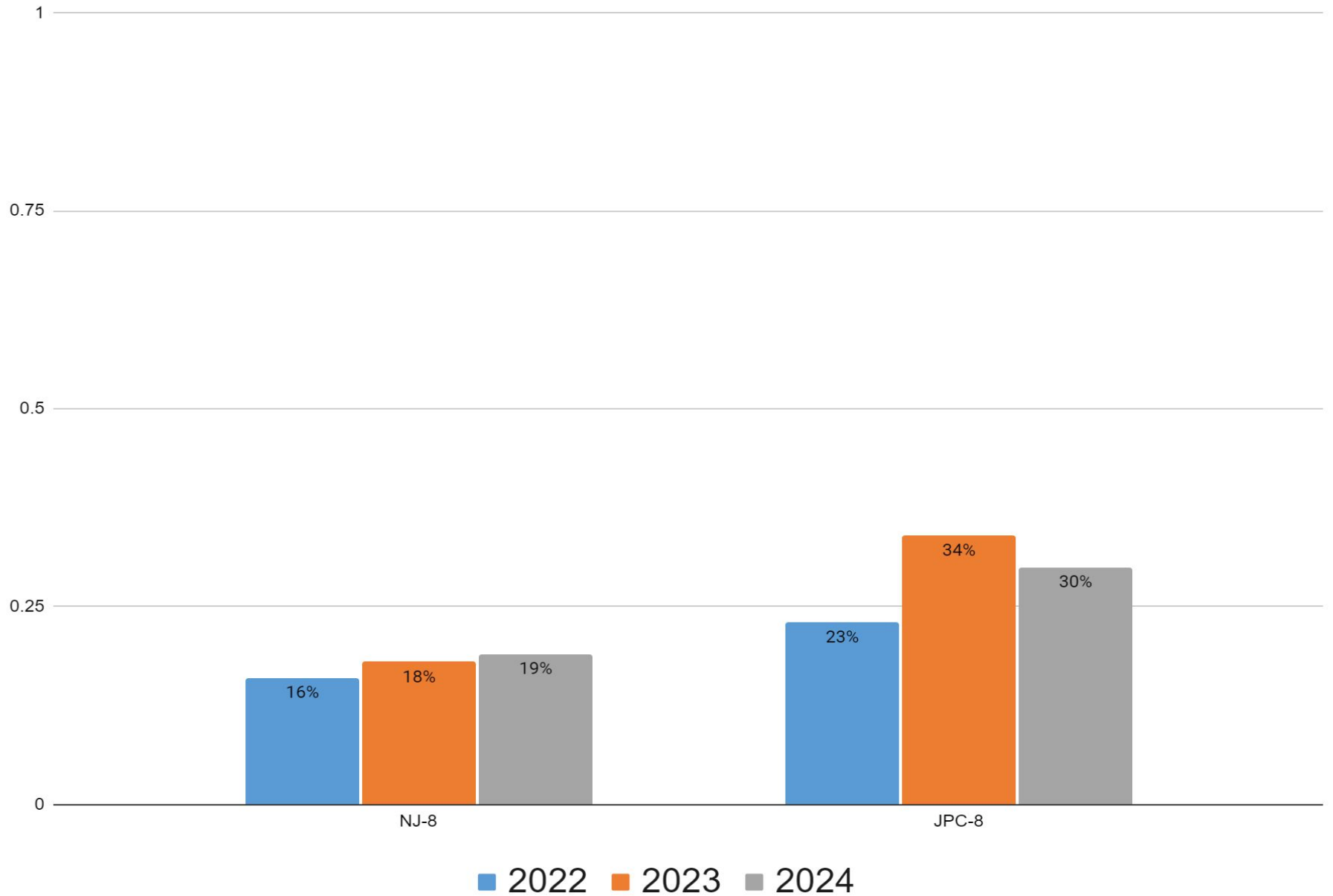

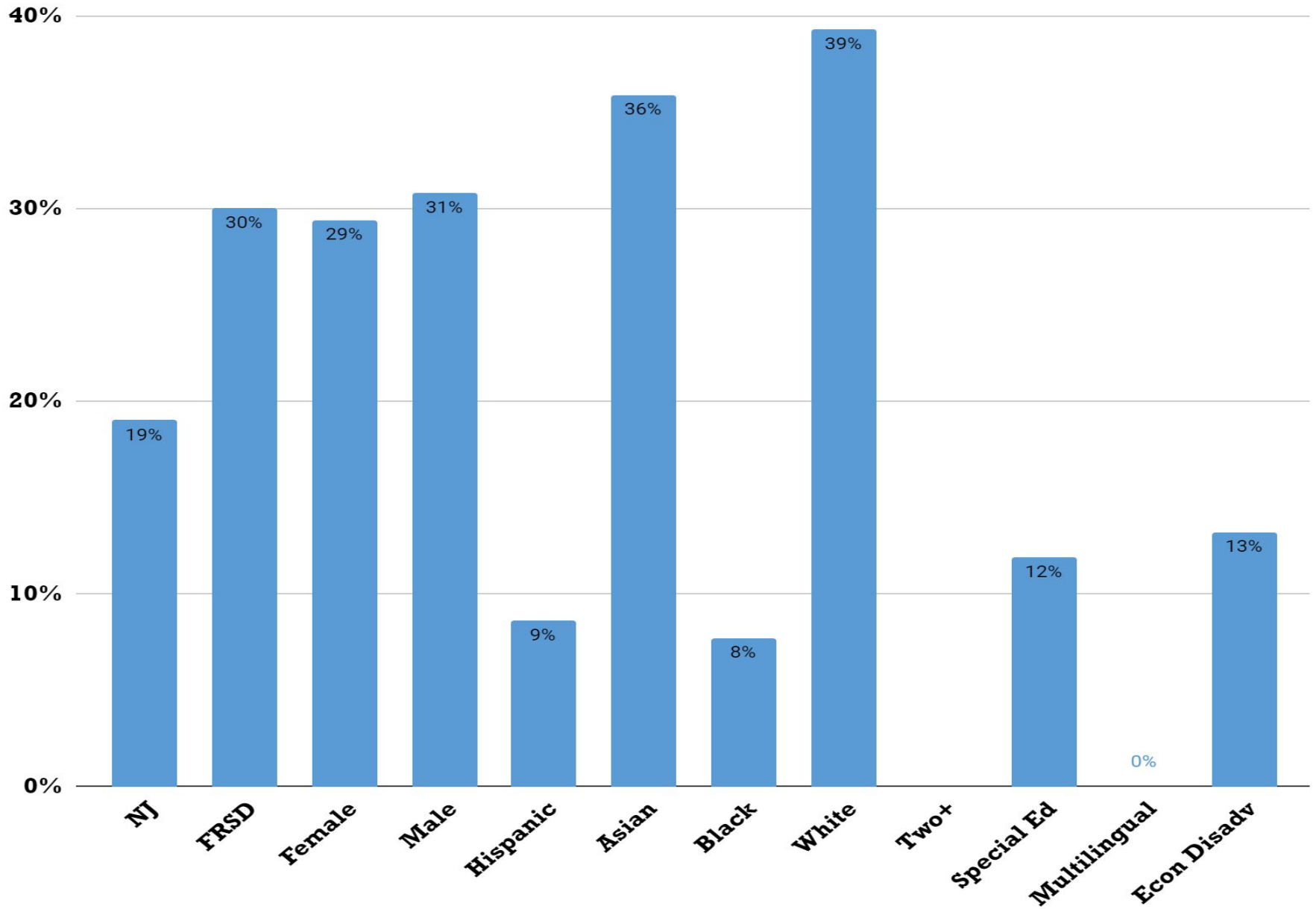

Science Grade 8 - Subpopulations

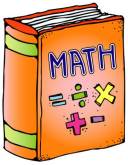

Grade 7 & 8 - Algebra I - Mathematics

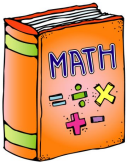

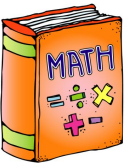

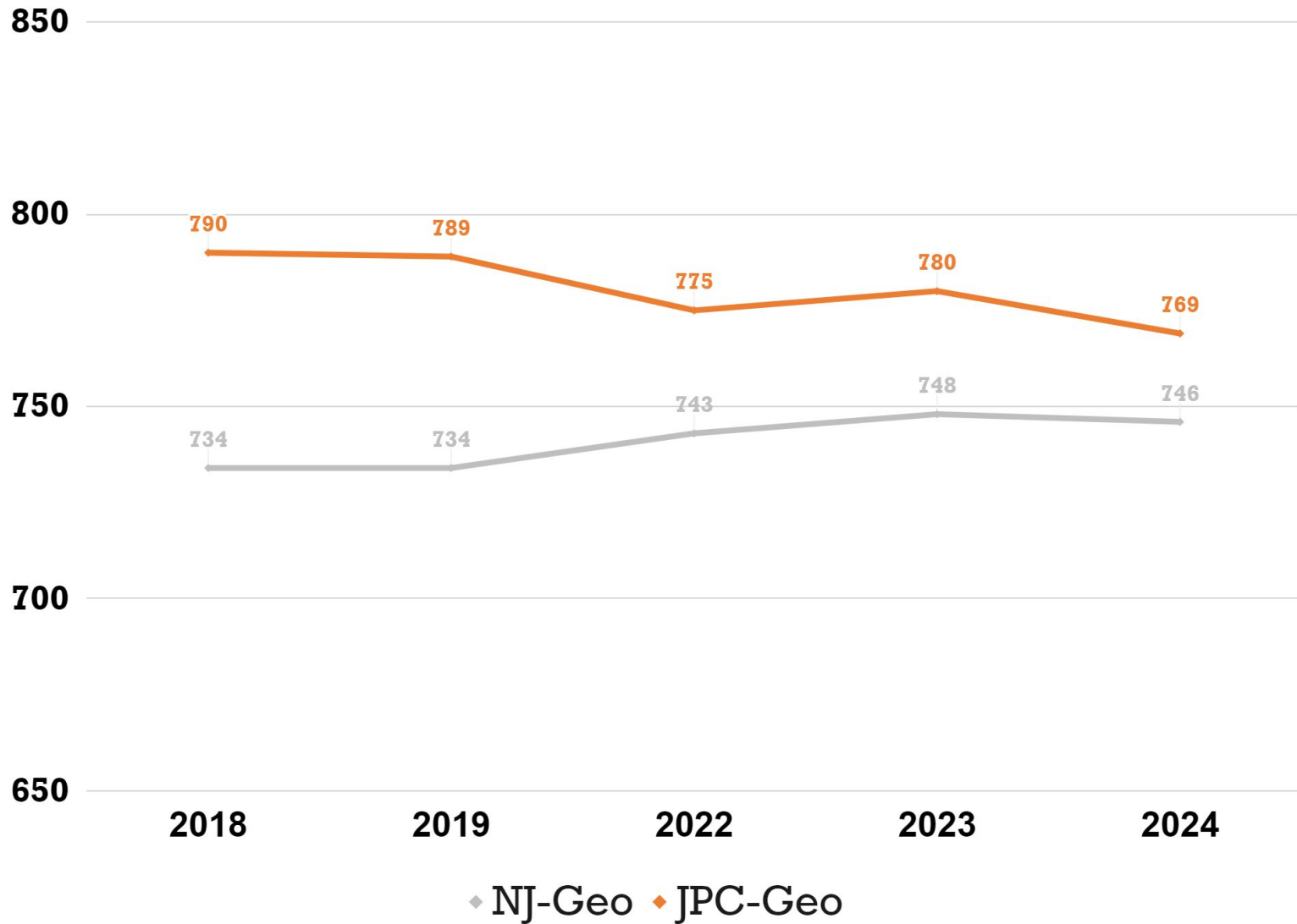

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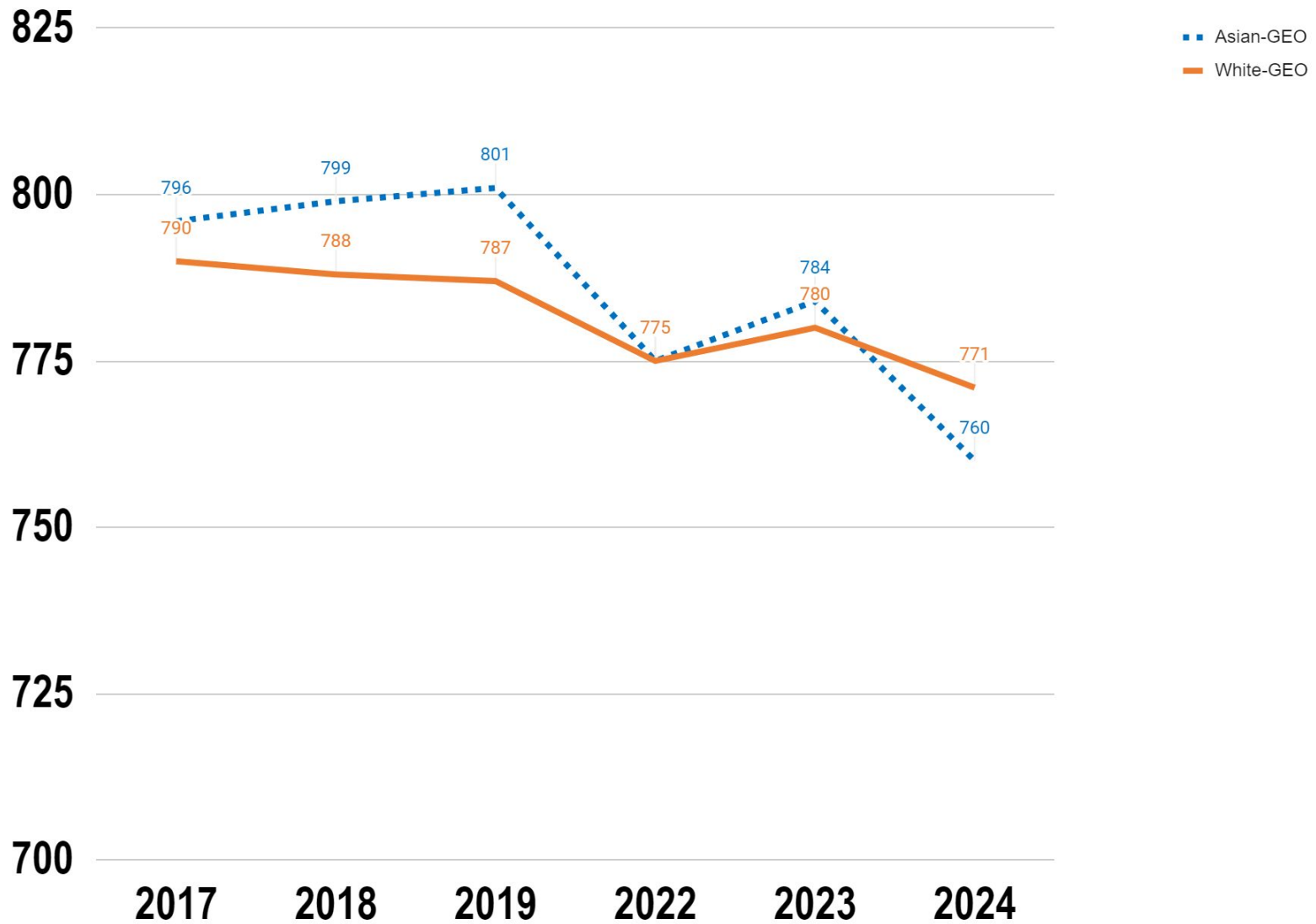


Geometry - Mathematics

GOALS/INTERVENTIONS FOR 2024-2025

Language Arts

- **Professional Development:** Provide multi-sensory reading training for literacy support teachers.
- **Curriculum Alignment:** Update ELA curriculum to align with NJ Student Learning Standards.
- **Book Club Opportunities:** Offer professional book clubs for teachers to update their knowledge of research-based best practices and improve their understanding of challenging texts.
- **Text Audit:** Conduct a review of classroom libraries and student reading materials to ensure sufficient complex text.
- **Early Literacy Support:** Implement early literacy screenings and interventions to identify and support struggling readers.
- **Decodable Texts:** Purchase decodable texts for elementary schools to aid teaching of early literacy skills.
- **Targeted Interventions:** Use the Just Words program in 5th-6th grade to support struggling readers and offer after-school tutoring and summer programs using grant funds.
- **Data Analysis Improvement:** Continue partnering with building administrators to improve data analysis and monitoring.

GOALS/INTERVENTIONS FOR 2024-2025

Mathematics

- Implementation of Bridges in Mathematics in grades K-5
- Pilot materials in grades 6-8 for Mathematics
- Utilize Bridges in Mathematics intervention program as needed for identified students in math support in K-5

Science

- Selected teachers at JP Case Middle School will be piloting Open Sci Ed in the fall. This open source curriculum has been highly rated and recommended by the NJDOE.
- Focused student Science and Math instruction in the reading and interpretation of graphs and tables.
