





10 Year Olds


- Quick to anger and quick to forgive



- Likes school work they see as purposeful: science experiments, drama productions, research





















In June 2023, RFIS Pollinator Garden became a Homegrown National Park!



Homegrown National Park[®] is a term coined by Doug Tallamy as a call-to-action. "Our National Parks, no matter how grand in scale are too small and separated from one another to preserve species to the levels needed. Thus, the concept for Homegrown National Park, a bottom-up call-to-action to restore habitat where we live and work, and to a lesser extent where we farm and graze, extending national parks to our yards and communities." Joining this effort is consistent with 5th and 6th grade science curriculum which includes biodiversity, ecosystems and climate change. The Homegrown National Parks website states, "We

are at a critical point of losing so many species from local ecosystems that their ability to produce the oxygen, clean water, flood control, pollination, pest control, carbon storage, etc, that is, the ecosystem services that sustain us, will become seriously compromised." 





Figure R. Sty Color Could

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
