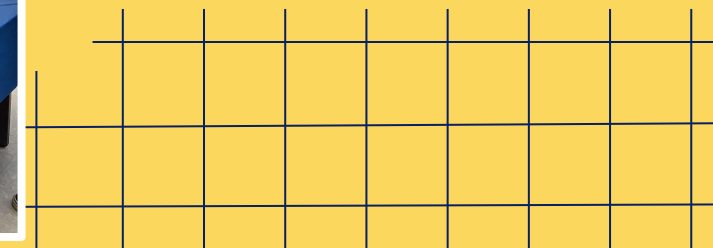
## Paws-itive Office Referrals

## Coaching and Teacher Led PD

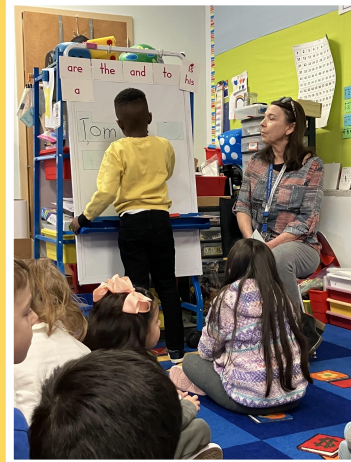
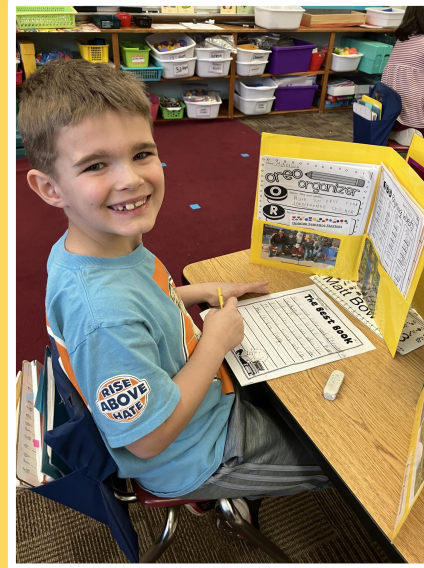

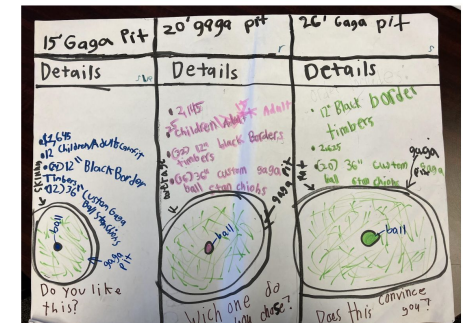
## WHO WILL USE THE GAGA PIT? WHERE WILL IT GO?
